1 Second Assistant Engineer for a term of three years

1 Third Assistant Engineer for a term of three years

1 Fourth Assistant Engineer for a term of three years

To cast their vote on the following question:

Shall the position of elected Clerk and Treasurer become an appointed Clerk and Treasurer, effective on or after July 1, 2026?


For these purposes, the polls shall be opened at 10:00 AM and shall be closed at 6:00 PM.


