**OPERATOR'S LICENSES:** The committee did not approve the operator's licenses, will take to the full board in July.

**TRAINING:** Mass Shooter training in Monroe on July 9, 2024.

**ANNOUNCEMENT AND FUTURE ITEMS:** The committee thanked Deanna Hubert for doing the outside fire sign for thirty years. Mueller has not been able to get in touch with Olivia Otte regarding a SAM number, the village can reach out to her and let her know to contact Mueller. Reidel suggested the Fire Dept conduct a strategic plan with a third-party mediator with a goal of improving their ISP rating and membership. Rescue Cable for dam.
