

## **PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Village Board of the Village of Albany, Wisconsin will conduct a public hearing at **6:30 p.m. on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of March 2026 in the Albany Village Hall located at 206 North Water Street** to consider the following item:

**Changing Village Ordinance 33-9: Open Burning.** The current ordinance allows the burning of dry combustible rubbish ONLY with certain restrictions. The hearing is to review the ordinance for possible consideration of changing this ordinance to NOT allow any type of burning of rubbish. The only types of burning in the village would consist of: outdoor fires for cooking, ceremonies, or recreation; controlled burning of small amounts of dry leaves, dry plan clippings, dry wood; fires set for practice and instruction of firemen; backfires to control forest fires or fires set for forest or wildlife habitat; and small open flames for welding, torches, or safety flares. Copies of both ordinances – current ordinance and proposed ordinance – are available at the Village Hall.
