OCTOBER 16, 2025

Approval of Agenda:

Lester Kriesel made a motion to approve the agenda as written. Rosie Walker seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.

Approval of Minutes from September 18, 2025:

Rosie Walker made a motion to approve the September 18, 2025 Park Committee meeting minutes as written. Mary Larson seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.

Trail Signs

Goose Lake Park Signs

Robb Rydmark would like to see a park like Young Park on the west side of Highway 169. Zac Good suggested looking at the property the City owns by Lake Diann.

Tom Rush would like to see a scoreboard at the ballfield at Young Park.

Other goals discussed were a splash pad, dog park, disc golf, Sandy Lake Beach improvements and looking at the 3 acres that the city owns located by Highway 169.

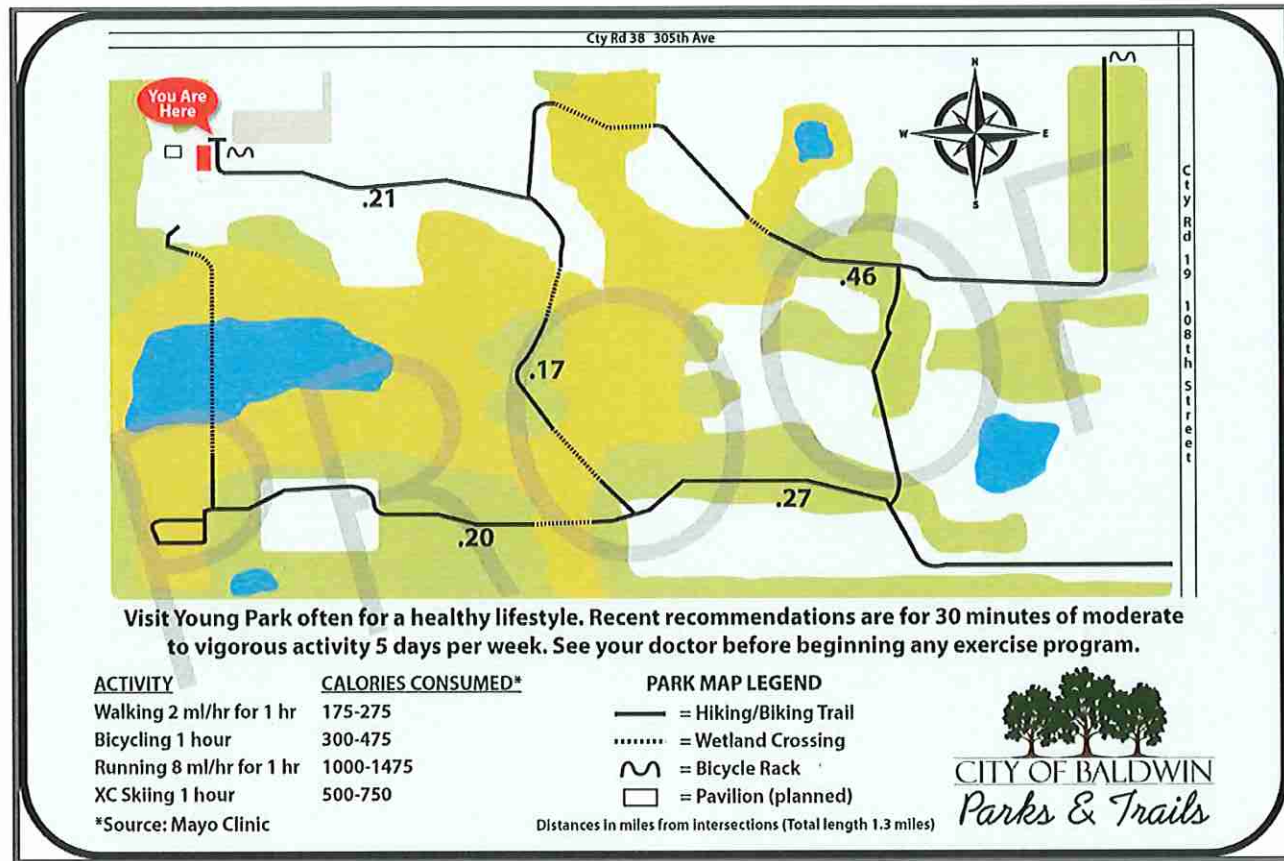

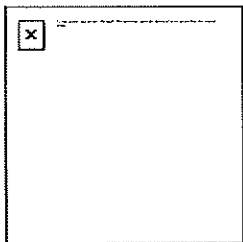
