The Common Council met at City Hall in the City of Black River Falls on June 4, 2024 at 6:00 P.M. Alderpersons Gearing-Lancaster, Wussow, Ammann, Peloquin, M. Rave, and Dougherty were present. Alderpersons E. Rave, and Olson attended remotely via Zoom meetings. Mayor J. Eddy presided.

It was moved by Alderperson Dougherty, seconded by Alderperson Gearing-Lancaster to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the May 7, 2024 Common Council meeting and approve as presented. Motion carried.

CITIZENS IN ATTENDANCE

There were 8 citizens in attendance for agenda items. 5 in person and 3 via Zoom.

Sheriff Waldera advised the Law Enforcement Committee set up a work group to discuss current directives of the committee and working through site locations. Current planning is for jail construction only. The Sheriff presented three conceptual jail designs that would require the closing of a city street. The options for street closures included N 3rd Street between Main Street and Harrison Street, Harrison Street between N 3rd Street and N 4th Street, or N 4th Street from Harrison to Tyler. The North 4th Street option would require the acquisition of three properties. The City Administrator advised City Department Heads felt closing N 3rd Street was the least favorable due to traffic, fire responses and just about every department head had concerns with this option. They were a little more open to closing Harrison Street, but still expressed concerns with traffic especially since Harrison is the main detour route for Main Street during closures for parades or any reason. N 4th Street had the least concerns other than they would be taking three more structures off the tax roll. N 4th Street was the least impactful on city operations and traffic. Alderperson Wussow advised she has received feedback from her constituents in Ward 3 who were against all three options. There was discussion on building up instead of out and the effect that would have on the design, staffing and long-term operational expenses. Alderperson Gearing-Lancaster advised she has heard the same feedback that closing N 3rd Street is not a popular option. The City Administrator advised the process for vacating a street is a question for the City Attorney but would entail two resolutions and public input. The Mayor expressed the city and county are partners and the city would like to support the project if the jail is built within the city with the least amount of impact and greatest benefit to all parties with public input. Alderperson Wussow shared questions from her constituents regarding the 19 classifications and what the Sheriff's Department really needs and if we are trying to compete with surrounding counties. The Sheriff offered an explanation on classifications, intake processes, the need for a jail, and this is not a competition just using their designs as references and opportunity to see what is working for them and what isn't.

It was moved by Alderperson Ammann, seconded by Alderperson M. Rave to approve the Mayor's appointments for 2024-2025 as presented. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderperson M. Rave, seconded by Alderperson Dougherty to approve the application for a Temporary Class B Beer (Picnic) License for the Rotary Club of Black River Falls for Festival in the Park July 13, 2024 at 1400 Tyler Street (Lunda Community Park). Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderperson Wussow, seconded by Alderperson Dougherty to approve the applications for renewal of Class A, B, and C Beer, Wine, Liquor, and Wholesale Retailer Licenses (2024-2025) as presented. Motion carried 7-0-1 with Alderperson M. Rave abstaining.

Sarah Peloquin addressed the Council regarding her request to increase the number of fowl city residents are allowed to keep from four (4) to at least six (6). There was discussion on the request and there were no objections to considering this change. The City Administrator will draft an ordinance and bring back to Council for consideration.

ORDINANCE 887 – An ordinance regarding plan examination for commercial buildings was presented to the Council. This was the first reading.

It was moved by Alderperson Ammann, seconded by Alderperson M. Rave to approve the Façade Improvement Grant Program for TIF #6. Motion carried.

The City Administrator provided an update on the shared ride taxi service. Total estimated deficit for 2024 in excess of budgeted/levied amount is now \$65,155.00 up from \$61,883.94 after receiving final federal and state grant distribution notice with lower than expected federal and state aid.

It was moved by Alderperson Dougherty, seconded by Alderperson Gearing-Lancaster to convene in to closed session for the purpose of deliberating the sale of public properties related to an offer to purchase a vacant lot on S. 1st Street, the sale of a portion of Parcel 010-0617.0005 and the purchase of property for access to Parcel 010-0617.0005 where competitive or bargaining reasons require a closed session which is authorized under Section 19.85(1)(e) of the Wisconsin Statutes. Motion carried at 7:05pm.

It was moved by Alderperson M. Rave, seconded by Alderperson Peloquin to reconvene in to open session to take or announce action, if any and if appropriate. Motion carried at 7:42pm.

It was moved by Alderperson Wussow, seconded by Alderperson M. Rave to counter offer the Offer to Purchase vacant land on S. 1st Street with the terms discussed in closed session. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderperson Ammann, seconded by Alderperson Wussow to authorize the City Administrator to pursue possible sale of a portion of Parcel 010-0617.0005 and purchase property for access road with the terms discussed in closed session. Motion carried.

It was moved by Alderperson Olson, seconded by Alderperson Peloquin to adjourn. Motion carried at 7:45pm.

The Committee of the Whole met at City Hall in the City of Black River Falls on June 19, 2024 at 6:00 P.M. Alderpersons Gearing-Lancaster, Ammann, and Peloquin were present. Alderpersons E. Rave, Olson, and Dougherty attended remotely via Zoom meetings. Alderpersons Wussow and M. Rave were excused. Mayor Jay Eddy presided.

1. There was one citizen in attendance. Jan Rousey addressed the Committee with a request that the City stop using Round-up to kill weeds. He referenced lawsuits in other communities linked to the use of Round-up and indicated all the bees in one of his two bee hives died last year and he believes it was linked to the spraying of weeds. Mayor Eddy indicated the City would look to see if there might be a more environmentally friendly option. Mr. Rousey recommended using a torch. Mr. Rousey also shared that the School District had erected a sign and a gate on a 40-acre parcel that the city owns $\frac{1}{4}$ of. The School District has agreed to remove the sign and gate and the land will be open to the public for hunting and fishing.
2. There were no updates on the County jail / justice center project.
3. The Department Head monthly reports were reviewed. Department heads present were Darryl Nelson, Jarod Meyer, Jody Stoker, Travis Brown, Cara Hart, and Brad Chown.
4. The Police Chief advised the supplemental report looks a little different because they recently switched over to a new reporting software. He is hoping they can add additional data to future supplemental reports to include information that appeared on past reports.
5. It was moved by Alderperson Ammann, seconded by Alderperson Peloquin to approve the Police Department's request to fill a vacant full-time Patrol Officer position. Motion carried.
6. It was moved by Alderperson Gearing-Lancaster, seconded by Alderperson Olson to approve the Police Department's request to sell the 2016 Ford F-150 patrol truck. Motion carried.
7. The Parks & Recreation Director advised Neuman Pools believes they have located the source of the leak. They are working on the repair which should be complete tomorrow morning and then the pool will be filled. Hope this is the solution and hope we can be open for the season.
8. The Fire Chief advised they have two new hires working through training.
9. The Street Superintendent advised the salt shed doors were damaged during a recent storm. The cost to rebuild the doors is \$2,900. This is an insurance claim and our deductible is \$1,000. They plan to shore it up to prevent future damage. Also, Municipal Utilities submitted their plans to the DNR so now there is a 4-30 day turn around time for approval. Street work will begin once approval is received.
10. It was moved by Alderperson Ammann, seconded by Alderperson Gearing-Lancaster to approve the vouchers for May 2024 Check #73980 - #74111 totaling \$318,149.13. Motion carried.

BLACK RIVER FALLS UTILITY COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

June 24, 2024

Utility Commission President John Lund called a meeting of the Black River Falls Municipal Utility Commission to order on June 24, 2024 at 3:28 p.m. in the Utility Conference Room at 349 South McKinley Street. Commissioners in attendance were Jeff Amo, Jay Eddy, Don Mathews and Pete Olson. Also present were General Manager Casey Engebretson, Electric Supt. Kevin LaValley, and Garrett Aleckson (Banner Journal).

A motion was made by Commissioner Olson and seconded by Commissioner Mathews to approve the minutes from the May 20, 2024 regular meeting.

Aye: Lund, Amo, Eddy, Mathews and Olson
Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Amo and seconded by Commissioner Eddy to approve the accounts payable vouchers; CK #42074 - #42152; and EP #100829 - #100836 – Totaling \$546,084.81.

Aye: Lund, Amo, Eddy, Mathews and Olson
Motion Carried.

The Commission reviewed the May arrears. Casey Engebretson stated that the higher 0-30 days arrears was the result of a larger commercial customer submitting a late payment.

Casey Engebretson reviewed the Aquifer Study and Well Site Investigation Report Agreement with SEH. The cost of the work was \$35,000.

A motion was made by Commissioner Amo and seconded by Commissioner Eddy to authorize Casey Engebretson to execute the agreement with SEH for the Aquifer Study and Well Site Investigation Report.

Motion Carried.

Casey Engebretson informed the Commission that the new phosphorus limit is effective July 1, 2024. WWTP staff have switched back to using a different phosphorus removal chemical and has received better, more consistent results.

Kevin LaValley provided a summary of the German Hill substation transformer failure. Kevin stated that our electrical engineer believes the transformer experienced an internal failure but further examination will be needed to determine the exact cause. Casey and Kevin are working with the insurance company to determine if this failure will be covered, which will likely depend largely on the detailed examination. They are also working with the engineer to find a temporary or permanent replacement option. Kevin reiterated that they are able to supply energy to all circuits by switching the load to the other substations, however, a separate failure could be devastating. Therefore, staff is working diligently for options, made more difficult by the supply chain issues.

Casey Engebretson informed the Commission that he has received the construction drawings and bid documents from Mead & Hunt for the forebay repair project. Casey requested authorization to

advertise for bids.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mathews and seconded by Commissioner Olson to authorize Casey Engebretson to publish the advertisement for bids for the forebay repair project.

The Commission discussed a revision to the handbook nepotism policy. Casey Engebretson presented a revised policy for consideration by the Commission. A discussion ensued.

Casey Engebretson provided an update on the 1000-hour employee recruitment process. Five (5) applications were received and all applicants possessed the minimum qualifications. Casey will begin scheduling interviews and estimates that any new hires would likely start around the end of July to early August.

Casey Engebretson presented a Community Contribution request from BRMH for the Mental Health Walk-A-Thon. Casey stated that the utility contributed a \$250 donation in 2023 and recommended approving the same this year.

A motion was made by Commissioner Amo and seconded by Commissioner Olson to approve a \$250 donation to BRMH.

BUILDING CODE 14.14 (7)

(7) PREVIOUSLY ERECTED ANTENNAS. Subject to sub. (7) above, this section shall not affect any satellite antenna erected prior to the adoption of this section.

14.15 HOUSE NUMBERING SYSTEM. See Sec. 8.12 of this Code.

14.16 NON-ASSUMPTION OF LIABILITY This chapter shall not be considered as assuming any liability on the part of the City or any official or employee thereof for damages to anyone injured or for any property destroyed by any defect in any building or equipment, or in any plumbing or electric wiring or equipment.

14.17 CERTIFIED MUNICIPALITY. The City has adopted the Certified Municipality Status as described in SPS 361.60 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code.

(1) **Responsibilities.** The City shall assume the following responsibilities for the Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department):

- a. Provide inspection of commercial buildings with certified commercial building inspectors.
- b. Provide plan examination of commercial buildings with certified commercial building inspectors.

(2) **Plan Examination.** Drawings, specifications, and calculations for all the types of buildings and structures, except state-owned buildings and structures, to be constructed within the limits of the municipality shall be submitted, if the plans are for any of the following:

- ~~a. A new building or structure containing less than 50,000 cubic feet of total volume.~~
- ~~b. An addition to a building or structure where the area of the addition results in the entire building or structure containing less than 50,000 cubic feet of total volume.~~
- ~~c. An addition containing no more than 2,500 square feet of total floor area and no more than one floor level, provided the largest roof span does not exceed 18 feet and the exterior wall height does not exceed 12 feet.~~
- ~~d. An alteration of a space involving less than 100,000 cubic feet of total volume.~~
- a. All commercial buildings, without size limitations.

LICENSES AND PERMITS 12.10(3)

(3) LOCATION. The area of the Farmers Market shall be designated by the Chief of Police.

(4) TIME AND HOUR OF OPERATION. The Farmers Market shall be open for operation each week day from June 1 through November 1 from 8:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M. Use of the Market at times other than those set forth herein may be available upon the consent of the Chief of Police.

(5) PENALTY. Any person who offers for sale the items set forth in sub. (1) above outside of the designated Farmers Market or who has not obtained a permit for the use of the Market shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a forfeiture of not less than \$10 nor more than \$100, together with the costs of prosecution.

→ **12.11 FOWL & FARM ANIMALS.** (1) Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to govern the ownership of non-traditional domestic animals in the city. This ordinance is not meant to conflict with any current ordinances governing traditional domestic animals. It also is not meant to supersede any zoning ordinances.

(2) Authority. The Common Council of the City of Black River Falls, Jackson County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority to adopt this Fowl and Farm Animal Ordinance under s. 66.0103 Wis. Stats.

(3) Adoption of Ordinance. This ordinance adopted on proper notice with a quorum and roll call vote by a majority of the Common Council present and voting, provides the authority for the City to regulate the ownership of fowl and other farm animals in the city.

(4) DEFINITIONS. The following definitions shall apply to this section:

- a) "Fowl" means any domestic breed of chicken or guinea hen. No other species of bird shall fall under this definition.
- b) "Livestock" means bovine animals, equine animals, goats, sheep, swine, farm-raised deer, farm-raised game birds, camelids, ratites, and farm-raised fish. In this definition, "swine" does not include potbelly pigs.

(5) RESTRICTIONS ON KEEPING OF FOWL AND OTHER FARM ANIMALS.

-
- a) No person shall keep any livestock within the city limits.
 - b) No person shall keep more than four (4) fowl on their property.
 - 1) None of the allowed fowl shall be roosters or male animals of the species.
 - c) No person shall keep more than four (4) rabbits on their property.
 - d) No person shall keep more than two (2) potbelly pigs on their property.
 - e) All animals that fall under this Section shall remain subject to the other applicable Chapters of the Municipal Code of Black River Falls.
