FROM THE TOWN - "Slope Stabilization" is a road project through the canyon that will be on-going thru the winter season. It will cause Hwy. 143 to be reduced down to one lane in areas; for periods of time. Watch for signs that alert drivers of the upcoming lane reductions; plan to drive slower due to road and weather conditions. There will be shuttle service beginning Thanksgiving weekend. 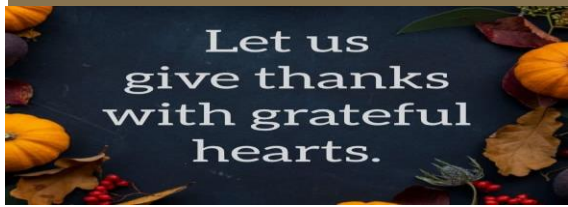
- The Resort will open for the Winter 2023-2024 Ski Season on November 10th.
