From Cedar Breaks Monument- Guided snowshoe tours are available at Cedar Breaks at the North View Overlook Friday and Saturdays, at 10am and noon. Entrance passes are \$25 per vehicle. The tours are family-friendly, beginner-friendly, and cover just 1 mile round-trip, making them perfect for all ages and skill levels. Snowshoes and ski poles are provided, and you'll enjoy a short, fun hike through the snowy sub-alpine forest.
