RESOLUTION NO. 26-572

**RESOLUTION DECLARING TOWN COUNCIL'S INTENT TO CONSIDER
ADOPTION OF A TRANSPORTATION UTILITY FEE, CALLING A PUBLIC
HEARING AND RELATED MATTERS.**

WHEREAS, according to Section 10-6-134.5 of the Utah Code, a Utah municipality may impose a transportation utility fee to provide funding for any number of transportation facilities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10-6-134.5 of the Utah Code, Brian Head Town has prepared a transportation utility fee analysis or study which establishes a need for maintaining, operating, repairing, upgrading, or replacing existing transportation facilities as well as a reasonable relationship between such need the services provided to or benefits received by persons who would pay the transportation utility fee; and

WHEREAS, the tentative budget presented by the Budget Officer includes a proposed transportation utility fee to fund transportation facility maintenance needs above and beyond those funded in previous budgets; and

WHEREAS, the Town is required to call and hold a public hearing regarding any proposed transportation utility fee and desires to do so:

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Brian Head, Utah as follows:

1. The Town Council intends to consider adoption of a transportation utility fee to fund additional road maintenance.
2. The Town Council hereby calls a public hearing on the transportation utility fee to be held on May 26, 2026, at the Town Hall (56 North Highway 143, Brian Head, UT). The public hearing on the transportation utility fee shall be held at 1:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as is feasible. All members of the public are invited to attend and participate by oral or written comment.
3. The Council directs the Budget Officer and Town Clerk to make the transportation utility fee study available to the public at the Town Hall and on the Town website until June 30, 2026.
4. The Town Council directs the Town Clerk to post and publish the notice of public hearing for the transportation utility fee at least 10 days before the public hearing in the following locations, (A) Utah Public Notice Website, (B) Town website, (C) at Town Hall, (D) electronically on the Utah Legals Website maintained by the newspapers of the State of Utah, and (E) on the Town's monthly utility bill. The Town Clerk is directed to retain evidence of each

posting and publication of this notice.

5. All parts of this Resolution are severable, and if any section, clause or provision of this Resolution shall, for any reason, be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of any such section, clause or provision shall not affect the remaining sections, clauses or provisions of this Resolution.
6. All resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed and this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its approval and adoption.
