about budget, anything we want to see or needs for the future please give ideas so we can work them in.

Police Chief Darrin Banning – Run down of calls, couple of well fare checks, hit and run, cases involving juveniles, car break ins, dog calls, assists to other agencies.

City Superintendent James Perry –Pool is up and running, Cemetery looks great, Mayor asked for estimate for cleaning and inspection of water tower James says last one was \$3-5,000. WE need to get one scheduled.
