

**MINUTES
BUHLER CITY COUNCIL
February 27, 2024**

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Jake Schmidt called the regular session of the City Council for the City of Buhler to order at 7:00 pm at the Buhler City Offices on Tuesday, February 27, 2024. Councilmembers present: Candace Davidson, Charles Taylor, and Ryan Brady. Councilmembers absent: Michael Yutzy and Andrew Epp.

CONSENT MOTION

Temporary Note-Buhler Industrial Park II- The original amount was not enough to cover the cost to finish project, there is a request to add funds to the existing Temporary note. **A motion was made by Councilmember Davidson, seconded by Councilmember Taylor to accept the Petition/Special Assessments and Resolution 2024-05 Amending Resolution 2022-08.** Voice vote 3 yeas, 0 nay – Carried. **A motion was made by Councilmember Brady, seconded by Councilmember Taylor approve Resolution 2024-06 Adopted Temporary Note Resolution.** Voice vote 3 yeas, 0 nay – Carried.

STAFF REPORTS

City Clerk Sara Howard-Expressed gratitude and gratefulness to everyone for their flexibility through this last month while she has not been able to come in. We have also received the renewal for insurance, it has gone up around \$10,000.

Assistant City Clerk Sarah Glass- We have now had two court sessions with new prosecutor and believes everyone is going to work great as we learn each other's processes. We have also had a lot of the Lead and Copper surveys returned so we are getting closer to having all the information we need for the state.

City Superintendent James Perry –The water meter for Well #4 has officially been ordered and should be here soon. They have started looking at streets that are needing repaired and there is a lot. The swimming pool work has started this week.

Police Chief Darrin Banning- All calls are on record in the office. Officer Isaiah Clubb starts Academy March 4 with Graduation June 7; he is very excited.

Buhler Wellness Director Tegan Meadors-Spring Break is in 2 weeks and we have many activities for kids. Next week we will start advertising for seasonal jobs. Summer activity guides will also be coming out either during spring break or the week after. The wellness center has improvements coming including and equipment replacement plan. They are also going to be working on getting the indoor pool resurfaced along with the outdoor pool.

Mayor Jake- Jake had some discussions on water usage at the diamonds and possible well options and on water line to east of town.
