Planning & Community Development

City Planner Vivian Likes congratulated Roger and Judy Kitchen on their retirement. They operated Kitchen Auto Body for 43 years. The business has been purchased by Chad Weiss of Complete Collision in Angola.

Police Department

Police Chief Mark Heffelfinger reported that the Butler Cemetery Mausoleum was vandalized over the weekend. Some windows were broken. He also reported 2,455 incidents for the year with 743 traffic stops.



Chief Heffelfinger also reported that the City will be getting two Flock cameras that monitor license plate numbers and alert authorities if any wanted vehicles are seen. They are \$3,000 each. Police Donation funds will be used for the first year.

Fire Department

Fire Chief Jimmie Eck reported that Ladder 39 is out of service for a week. The lift cylinder for the ladder needs to be repairs, this is a common wear item on ladder trucks.

City Attorney

City Attorney Don Stuckey presented the new Garbage & Recycling Contract with GFL. It is for a term of three years. There was discussion. Mr. Haywood made a motion to approve the contract and authorized Mayor Hartman to sign it. Mr. Johnson seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.

Clerk-Treasurer

Clerk-Treasurer Angela Eck presented a quote for an ADA Hearing System from Audio Visual Systems of Angola. It has a price of \$3,891.59. She will need to find out how many headsets that includes. She also requested assistance from the Board in finding additional providers so that additional quotes could be obtained. There was discussion. Mr. Haywood made a motion to approve the quote contingent upon no other vendors be found by Friday, December 22nd. Mr. Johnson seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.

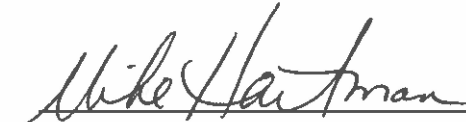
Total Bond Payments \$633,168.69

Mr. Johnson made a motion to adjourn at 6:57 and Mr. Haywood seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.



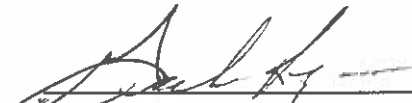
