Water Superintendent Andy Cintron reported that the required testing for PFAS came back as negative. It is very good for the City!

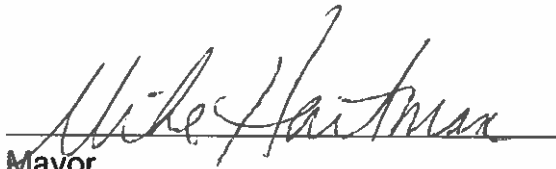
