Police Chief Matt Traster requested that discussion on the proposed new Six-Year agreement with Axon be table until the next meeting when Assistant Chief Cory Rowe will be present for questions, he is the one working on it.

Chief Traster reported that the Police Department has various weapon parts that they no longer need and would like to sell. He is aware that all items need to be sold through auction. Municibid does not handle weapons on their website. He recommends that gunbroker.com be used for these parts. There was discussion. Mr. Smith made a motion to approve the Police Department using gunbroker.com to sell unneeded weapons and parts. Mr. Haywood seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.

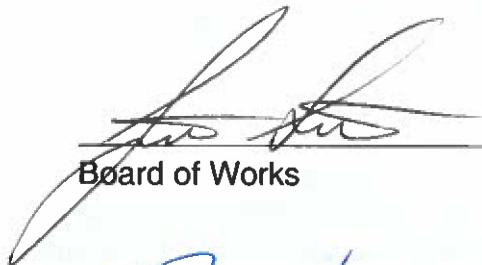
Wastewater

Wastewater Superintendent Gavyn Aden presented quotes for new samplers that are needed at the Wastewater Treatment Plant. He plans on moving the old samplers to the storm facility and putting the new ones at the main plant. He stated that the quotes from USA Bluebook are cheaper, but that they do not match up with the existing equipment. He would like to stay with the same brand of equipment for consistency. He would also like to purchase a one year extended warranty for each new sampler. There was discussion. Mr. Smith made a motion to purchase the samplers, with the extended warranties, from Gripp at a cost not to exceed \$29,943. Mr. Haywood seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.

Mr. Haywood made a motion to adjourn at 6:43 pm and Mr. Smith seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.



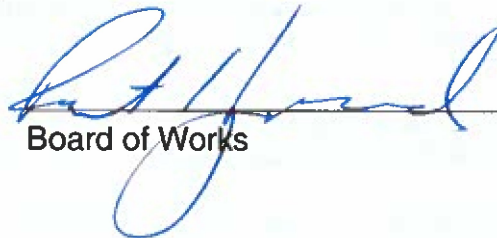
