Mayor Hartman opened the regular session of the Board of Works at 6:30 pm at 215 South Broadway.

The minutes from the March 2nd meeting were presented. Mr. Haywood made a motion to approve the minutes and Mr. Smith seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.

Mayor Hartman asked for comments or questions from audience pertaining to the agenda items.

Payments and Vouchers

Pay Period 2/23 to 3/8 in the amount of \$41,612.53

Mr. Smith made a motion to approve the claims and vouchers as presented and Mr. Haywood seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.



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Utility Billing Adjustment Requests:

Mr. Haywood made a motion to approve the adjustments and Mr. Smith seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.

Fire Department

Fire Chief Ron Mausteller reported that the Fire Department will be responsible for \$7,099 on the new brush truck. This is due to an upgrade from the original hose reel that was quoted to the DeKalb County Redevelopment Commission. Chief Mausteller did send the Board of Works members information about this prior to the meeting. He requested that the Board approve \$7,099 to Spencer Fire Truck Manufacturing. Mr. Haywood made a motion to approve the payment and Mr. Smith seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.

Chief Mausteller also presented a proposal from Priority 1 for monitoring the fire alarm at the fire station. The annual monitoring cost is \$500 but some new equipment will need to be installed at a cost of \$1,358. There was discussion. Mr. Smith made a motion to approve the cost not to exceed \$1,858 and Mr. Haywood seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.

Water

Water Superintendent Andy Cintron presented an estimate to repair the intersection of State Road 1 and US 6. He recommends WCCI because if we wait for asphalt to do the repair it will be around another month. WCCI is available now to pour concrete for the repair at an estimate of \$15,750. Mr. Smith made a motion to approve WCCI at a cost not to exceed \$15,750 and Mr. Haywood seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.

Wastewater

Wastewater Superintendent Gavyn Aden presented an estimate from American Pump for two replacement pumps at the Treatment Plant. The cost is \$12,226 or \$24,452 for two of them. Mr. Haywood made a motion to approve the replacement pumps and Mr. Smith seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.

Mayor

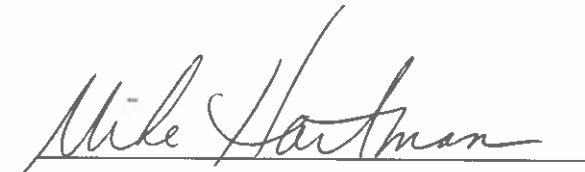
Mayor Hartman presented a Special Event Request for the State Road 1 Garage sales, which will be held on May 16th. Mr. Haywood made a motion to approve the special event and Mr. Smith seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.

Mayor Hartman also presented a proposal from Priority 1 for fire alarm monitoring at City Hall. The annual monitoring fee would be \$500 and there would be an additional equipment cost of \$195 for the first year. Mr. Smith made a motion to approve the proposal at a cost not to exceed \$695 and Mr. Haywood seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.

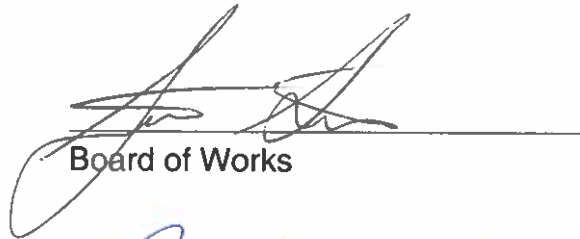


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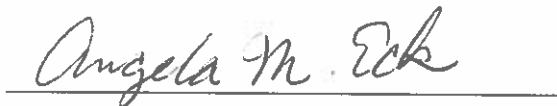
Mr. Smith made a motion to adjourn at 6:50 pm and Mr. Haywood seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.



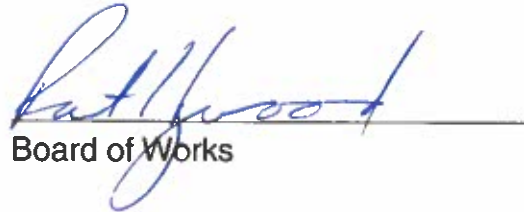
