Planning Department

City Planner Andrew Provines reported that the Park Board will be hosting three movie nights at South Side Park this summer. They are requesting \$1000 per movie, or \$3,000 in total. This will cover the cost of the movies and any snacks or craft items they decide to provide. There was discussion. Mr. Smith made a motion to approve the request for \$3,000 and Mr. Haywood seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.

Fire Department

Fire Chief Ron Mausteller reported that the new air packs should be delivered the first or second week of June. The brush truck is not in service yet because of a programming issue with Ford.

Water

Water Superintendent Andy Cintron reported that the water main break last week required a new valve. He does not have the invoice for it yet but expects it to be around \$3,000. He also thanked the employees from Ferguson for working late and making sure the valve was delivered to him.

Mayor Hartman reported that he is still working with Verizon on the land lease for a new cellular tower. Verizon needs to know what dollar figure the City needs their bond to be in. There was discussion. Mr. Stuckey stated that the standard \$10,000 will be acceptable because Verizon will still be required to repair anything that they damage.


Mayor Hartman presented special event requests from a Coffee Truck vendor and another from Melinda Ebers for the Butler Days 5K. Mr. Haywood made a motion to approve the special event requests and Mr. Smith seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.
