Mayor Hartman opened the regular session of the Common Council at 7:30 pm at 215 South Broadway.

Pledge of Allegiance

Mayor Hartman asked for comments or questions from the audience pertaining to the agenda items. None



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The minutes from the July 6th meeting were presented. Council Member Eldridge made a motion to approve the minutes and Council Member Ryan seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.

Proposed Resolution 26-677, Create an Income Tax Revolving Loan Fund, was presented. Council Member Alloway made a motion to approve Resolution 26-677 and Council Member Eldridge seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.

Proposed Resolution 26-678, Entering into an Economic Development Agreement with Kiracofe Homes, LLC, was presented. Kiracofe is in the process of purchasing 2 parcels that contain 20 acres at a price of \$400,000 to build up to 38 homes on. There was discussion. Council Member Alloway made a motion to approve Resolution 26-678 and Council Member Ryan seconded the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.

Mayor Hartman opened the floor for discussion about changes to the ORV Ordinance.

Council Member Alloway stated that he is in favor of updating the ordinance to accept stickers from other communities and requiring a certain speed for the more highly travelled streets. Council Member Ryan agreed.

Amanda Knapp reported that people driving golf carts have been seen near Dollar General

There was discussion about which roads or streets should be modified in the ORV ordinance. County Roads 28, 63, 24 and 32 were agreed upon. Council Member Alloway made a motion to modify the regulations for these roads with Council Member Ryan seconding the motion. The motion passed with all in favor.

There was further discussion about reaching out to other communities to see what they have done about travel on state roads.

City Planner Andrew Provines reported that there would be a Public Hearing at the August 3rd meeting to rezone a property.

Street Superintendent Kris Tadsen reported that concrete has been poured for the speed sign on Liberty Street. The actual sign should be installed soon.



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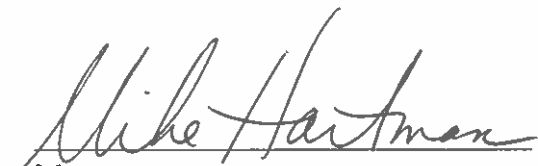
IT Specialist Braxton Minkey reported that he has sent an email to all of the City employees providing information about phishing emails and how to detect them. He asked everyone to please read the email.
