

Special Meeting, City Council Proceedings

The Canistota City Council met Thursday, February 13, 2025 at 7:00 AM in special session in the Canistota City Hall Community Room. The following Council was present: Mayor Justin Lee Engbarth, Jamie Miller, Donovan O'Donnell and Jerry Bertelson. Matt Anderson was absent. Others present: Maintenance Supervisor Darin Nugteren, Maintenance Assistant, Brandon Dolejsi and Finance Officer Kathy J. Townsend.

Mayor Engbarth called the meeting to order at 7 AM and led the pledge.

O'Donnell, second by Miller, motioned to approve the agenda as presented, all voted yes, the motion carried.

No one was present for citizen concerns.

Mayor Engbarth:

Bertelson motioned, second by O'Donnell to adopt Ordinance 2025-04, A Comprehensive Regulation for Flood Damage Prevention in the City of Canistota. Because an emergency is hereby declared to exist, this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and shall be in full force and effect from and after it's passage and approval. All voted yes, the motion carried. The Notice of Adoption is printed elsewhere in this edition of The Special.

Bertelson motioned, supported by O'Donnell to authorize the replacement and purchase of a new grandstand for approximately \$140,000.00 to be installed at The Wendall Anderson Memorial Sports Complex with Canistota Public School paying 40 percent of the entire completed project, CHS will pay one hundred percent of the cost to replace the sound system at the Complex. It is further agreed the City of Canistota will not raise the rental fee for the school's use of the Complex for ten (10) years, the rental fee will remain at \$5,000.00 annually, all voted yes, the motion carried.

Miller motioned, second by Bertelson to declare the existing grandstand as surplus property with Nugteren and Dolejsi advertising the sale of the grandstand on several area print and social media platforms, all voted yes, the motion carried.

At 7:21 AM Miller motioned to adjourn, second by O'Donnell, all voted yes, the motion carried.

The next regular Council meeting will be held in the Community Room of City Hall on Monday, March 3, 2025 at 6 PM, all are welcome and encouraged to attend.
