To cast their votes in the Town Election for the candidates for the following offices:

- 1 Moderator.....for a term of Three Years
- 2 Selectmen.....for a term of Three Years Each
- 3 Constables.....for a term of Three Years Each
- 1 Assessor.....for a term of Three Years
- 1 Board Of Health Member.....for a term of Three Years
- 1 Planning Board Member.....for a term of Five Years
- 1 Water Commissioner.....for a term of Three Years
- 1 Cemetery Commissioner.....for a term of Three Years
- 1 Northern Berkshire Regional Vocational School District Committee Member – Cheshire Representative.....for a term of Three Years
- 1 Hoosac Valley Regional School District Committee Member – Cheshire Representative.....for a term of Three Years
- 2 Hoosac Valley Regional School District Committee Members – Adams Representatives.....for a term of Three Years Each
