1. Roll Call

The Joint Police Committee was called to order at 5:30 pm and roll call was taken. All members present.

2. Approval of the January 6, 2026 Joint Police Committee Agenda

Motion by Hewitt, second by Dunnington to approve the January 6, 2026 Joint Police Committee meeting agenda. Motion carried unanimously (6 – 0).

3. Approval of the December 12, 2025 Joint Police Committee Meeting Minutes

Motion by Hewitt, second by Dunnington to approve the December 12, 2025 Joint Police Committee meeting minutes. Motion carried unanimously (5 – 0 – 1, Jacobson abstained).

The committee will need to approve the minutes from the October meeting at the next meeting. Cambridge to send Clerk Gingher the minutes of that meeting.

4. Review and discussion of Court and Police Reports **a. Court: September, October & November**

Motion by Jacobson, second by Dunnington to approve the court reports for September, October and November. Motion carried unanimously (6-0)

- b. Police: September, October, November & December

Deputy Corrigan provided highlights on major incidents: attempted homicide suspect instance, which created additional cases. Some calls started as domestic in the reports, which resulted in additional resources but were later changed to other categories. "Shop with a Cop" took place in December with three children in the community.

Trendel, is there a way to put the quarter statistics on one page (executive summary) so the data can be a little more concise and trends can be seen?

There is a car that is in the way of Public Works plows on Washburn that has been ticketed.

Motion by Jacobson, second by Hewitt to approve the police reports for September, October and November. Motion carried unanimously (6-0)

5. Preliminary discussions on the police services contract with the Dane County Sheriff's Office

Every person who signed the contract is no longer in the stated positions. It also listed the names of both villages and not the positions. It does not mention how the deputy selection process works, as it states it is up to the Sheriff's Office. Deputies are employees of the county and not of the villages, so that could be a factor in potential lawsuits.

Additionally, the contract does not specify that other deputies will be called when the village-dedicated deputies are unavailable. Also, we need to determine if there is coverage for a deputy who is on extended leave. Deputy Corrigan states that typically, they will work eight hours of overtime a week if additional coverage is needed, as there has not been a dedicated additional deputy to provide coverage. There could be an option for a "temporary fill-in."

Wieczorek would like the committee to review the existing contract, and Deputy Corrigan will invite Captain Simpson (new to the role) to the next meeting.

6. Discussion on schedule and work hours of the Dane County Sheriff's Deputies

Wieczorek would like to understand how coverage is going with Deputy Lauritsen, now retired.

Deputy Corrigan stated that detective interviews are on January 20, which include a potential candidate for our village deputies that the committee interviewed.

Deputies Corrigan and O'Donnell sat down and went through their schedules to ensure there is coverage for the villages, specifically from 1 p.m. – 6 p.m., which is the highest call volume

period. The entire Sheriff's Office is on 8-hour shifts.

Wieczorek stated that if the villages had 24/7 coverage, we would need six deputies.

7. Consideration to move into closed session pursuant to Wis. Stat. 19.85(1)(c) to discuss employment of a Dane County Sheriff's Deputy dedicated to the Villages of Cambridge and Deerfield

Motion by Hewitt, second by Dunnington to not move into closed session. Motion carried unanimously (6 - 0).

8. Set next committee meeting: date, time, and location.

Next meeting the Captain Simpson will be invited, so we need to determine if we hold the meeting on February 3 or 10.

Motion by Dunnington seconded by Trendel to hold the next committee meeting on Tuesday, February 10, 2026 at 5:00 pm at the Deerfield Village Hall. Motion carried unanimously (6 – 0).

9. Adjournment

Motion by Dunnington seconded by Hewitt to adjourn the Joint Police Committee meeting at 6:16p.m. Motion carried unanimously (6 – 0).

The Villages of Cambridge and Deerfield have agreed to compensate Dane County for these services. This contract is a summary and incorporation of all previous agreements and addendums with the Villages of Cambridge and Deerfield.

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into by and between David Mahoney, acting solely in his official capacity as Dane County Sheriff (hereinafter referred to as "SHERIFF"), the County of Dane (hereafter, "COUNTY"), the Village of Cambridge (hereafter, "CAMBRIDGE") and the Village of Deerfield (hereafter, "DEERFIELD"),

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS COUNTY, whose address is c/o County Clerk, 112 City-County Building, Madison, WI 53703, finances a Sheriff's office as required by the laws of this state; and

WHEREAS SHERIFF, whose address is Room 2000, 115 West Doty Street, Madison, WI 53703, is the duly elected and qualified Sheriff of the County of Dane and as Sheriff, manages and directs the operations of the Dane County Sheriff's Office in providing police services throughout the territorial limits of the County of Dane; and

WHEREAS CAMBRIDGE, whose address is c/o April Little, Village Clerk, P. O. Box 99, Cambridge, WI 53523, desires to purchase law enforcement services from SHERIFF in addition to those services which SHERIFF is required to provide by statute, and CAMBRIDGE being willing to assume the cost of such additional services; and

WHEREAS DEERFIELD, whose address is c/o Dean Otte, Village Clerk, P. O. Box 66, Deerfield, WI 53531, desires to purchase law enforcement services from SHERIFF in addition to those services which SHERIFF is required to provide by statute, and DEERFIELD being willing to assume the cost of such additional services; and

WHEREAS SHERIFF is willing to assign State of Wisconsin-certified sworn law enforcement officers to act as the law enforcement officers for CAMBRIDGE and DEERFIELD, (hereafter referred to collectively as "MUNICIPALITIES") provided MUNICIPALITIES are willing to pay for the services of such officers; and

WHEREAS COUNTY is willing to consent to such an arrangement provided its costs are adequately reimbursed by MUNICIPALITIES;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above premises and the mutual covenants of the parties hereinafter set forth, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged by each party for itself, SHERIFF, COUNTY, CAMBRIDGE and DEERFIELD do agree as follows:

49
50 1. The term of this Agreement shall commence as of the date by which all parties hereto have
51 executed this Agreement and shall end as of the EXPIRATION DATE set forth on page 1 hereof,
52 unless sooner agreed to by the parties.

53
54 2. MUNICIPALITIES shall reimburse COUNTY its actual cost of providing law enforcement
55 services under this Agreement. COUNTY shall bill for its costs according to the rates set forth in
56 Schedule A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. COUNTY will invoice
57 CAMBRIDGE once every four weeks, each invoice covering two consecutive COUNTY pay-
58 periods. CAMBRIDGE will be responsible for making payment to the COUNTY for both
59 DEERFIELD and CAMBRIDGE pursuant to a formula to be mutually agreed upon by DEERFIELD
60 and CAMBRIDGE. Payment to COUNTY is due 30 days after date of invoice. Invoices shall
61 specify the name of each deputy providing services under this Agreement together with the hours
62 of service provided, to the nearest whole hour. COUNTY shall be reimbursed its costs plus any
63 overtime the assigned deputies may be required to work under paragraph 3 or paragraph 12, or
64 both, of this Agreement. For purposes of this Agreement, "overtime" is defined as an individual's
65 work hours in excess of 37½ hours per week or 8 hours per day.

66
67 3. SHERIFF will assign four (4) Sheriff's deputies to MUNICIPALITIES as set forth in Schedule
68 A, with all necessary equipment, to provide to law enforcement services at an average annual
69 work week of 37.5 hours per deputy (not including overtime or court time related to this Agreement
70 but including vacation, sick leave, training, and other authorized time off work). It is understood
71 that the four assigned deputy Sheriffs will serve as the assigned deputies in the MUNICIPALITIES
72 and the assigned deputies will not be replaced when on vacation, sick leave, training or other
73 absence from work. The parties recognize that from time to time either CAMBRIDGE or
74 DEERFIELD may request services which necessitate that an assigned deputy work overtime or be
75 assisted or replaced by another deputy who is on overtime.

76
77 4. SHERIFF shall have supervisory control over the personnel providing services under this
78 Agreement. SHERIFF shall retain the final authority to make decisions as to the manner in which
79 services shall be rendered.

80
81 5. SHERIFF will provide patrol functions within the boundaries of the MUNICIPALITIES.
82 During patrol hours, the assigned deputies will provide continuous patrol within the boundaries of
83 the MUNICIPALITIES, subject to breaks, lunch times, and those situations which require mutual
84 aid assistance by COUNTY. The assigned deputies, unless otherwise occupied, will be first
85 responder to all dispatched events in the MUNICIPALITIES.

86
87 6. Consistent with the SHERIFF's judgment as to good police practices, every effort will be
88 made to respond to MUNICIPALITIES' needs and desires. CAMBRIDGE and DEERFIELD will
89 each designate a liaison to provide SHERIFF with any information relative to the assigned
90 deputies' performance and special assignments requested by either CAMBRIDGE or DEERFIELD.
91 The liaison will deal directly with the Captain of Field Services.

92
93 7. COUNTY reserves the right to increase its monthly charges to MUNICIPALITIES, to reflect
94 labor agreement settlements affecting the assigned deputies' salary, fringe benefits, and any other
95 increased costs which occur within the term of this Agreement. In addition, COUNTY will bill
96 MUNICIPALITIES retroactively for any increased costs attributable to such labor agreement
97 settlements when COUNTY's costs of providing services under this Agreement are affected
98 thereby.

8. COUNTY shall provide one (1) vehicle to be used by the deputies providing services pursuant to this Agreement. This vehicle and all equipment contained therein, shall remain the property of COUNTY. MUNICIPALITIES shall reimburse SHERIFF the cost of the COUNTY provided vehicle as set forth in Schedule A.

9. CAMBRIDGE has one (1) squad car and DEERFIELD has one (1) squad car which shall be available for use by the deputies performing services under this Agreement. These vehicles, including equipment and portable radio, will be comparable and compatible to Sheriff's Office vehicles and shall be kept in good working order. Each MUNICIPALITY shall be responsible for the costs associated with the maintenance of its squad car

10. CAMBRIDGE and DEERFIELD shall each provide and maintain an office for use by the deputies providing services under this Agreement. Each office shall include a telephone, a fax machine, a photocopying machine, a computer capable of interfacing with the Dane County Sheriff's Office records system, office supplies, and clerical support.

11. COUNTY and MUNICIPALITIES shall retain title to the property each may acquire to fulfill its obligations under this Agreement.

12. CAMBRIDGE and DEERFIELD will each operate a municipal court. Deputies assigned under this Agreement will enforce all local ordinances for which MUNICIPALITIES empower them and will issue citations using forms supplied by the MUNICIPALITIES. The assigned deputies will attend all required court appearances on all municipal citations; MUNICIPALITIES' attorney or attorneys will handle the prosecution of those matters in any court proceedings. Overtime expenses incurred as a consequence of court appearances by the assigned deputies shall be reimbursed to COUNTY in accordance with par. 2 above. It is further agreed that the fines or forfeitures for State charges shall be turned over to COUNTY and the fines and forfeitures for those offenses that are violations of either CAMBRIDGE or DEERFIELD's ordinances will be turned over to the village issuing the citation.

13. MUNICIPALITIES will defend, hold harmless and indemnify COUNTY and SHERIFF, the officers and employees of each, for any claim brought against them or any of them founded in or growing out of the negligence or improper act of MUNICIPALITIES or conduct of any official, agent or employee of MUNICIPALITIES. It is expressly understood that MUNICIPALITIES will not defend, hold harmless or indemnify COUNTY and SHERIFF relative to alleged negligence or improper conduct, or both, of any COUNTY employee or SHERIFF assigned deputies other than those hired directly by MUNICIPALITIES as part time officers outside of this Agreement.

14. This Agreement shall stand automatically renewed for successive single calendar year terms, under the same conditions and provisions as set forth herein, unless SHERIFF signifies his or her objection in writing at least 30 days prior to the expiration date. Commencing January 1, 2009, and in addition to the termination provisions of paragraph 16, any party may terminate this Agreement or any renewal term thereof on at least 180 days written notice, effective at the end of a calendar year.

15. No party shall assign any interest in this Agreement without the expressed written consent of the other parties which consent may be withheld in the sole discretion of the party.

16. If during the term of this Agreement, a governing body of either COUNTY or MUNICIPALITIES shall fail to appropriate sufficient funds to carry out that party's obligations under this Agreement, the same shall be automatically terminated as of the date funds are no longer

151 available and without further notice of any kind to any other party. This paragraph shall not relieve
152 MUNICIPALITIES of their responsibility to pay for services furnished prior to the effective date of
153 termination.

155 17. The parties shall commence, carry on and complete their respective obligations under this
156 Agreement with all deliberate speed and in a sound, economical and efficient manner, in
157 accordance with this Agreement and all applicable laws. In providing services under this
158 Agreement, each party agrees to cooperate with the various departments, agencies, employees
159 and officers of the other parties.
160

161 18. COUNTY and MUNICIPALITIES all agree to secure at their own expense all personnel
162 necessary to carry out that party's obligations under this Agreement. Such personnel shall not be
163 deemed to be employees of the other parties (except that SHERIFF's deputies and employees are
164 also employees of COUNTY) nor shall they or any of them have or be deemed to have any direct
165 contractual relationship with any another party. Notwithstanding the foregoing, off-duty SHERIFF's
166 deputies hired directly by MUNICIPALITIES shall during the course of such employment be
167 considered as employees of MUNICIPALITIES and not of COUNTY or SHERIFF.

169 19. Notices, bills, invoices and reports required by this Agreement shall be deemed delivered as
170 of the date of postmark if deposited in a United States mailbox, first class postage attached,
171 addressed to a party's address as set forth above. It shall be the duty of a party changing its
172 address to notify the other parties in writing within a reasonable time.

174 20. In no event shall the making of any payment or acceptance of any service required by this
175 Agreement constitute or be construed as a waiver by the making or accepting party of any breach
176 of the covenants of this Agreement or a waiver of any default of any other party and the making of
177 any such payment or acceptance of any such service by one party while any such default or
178 breach shall exist shall in no way impair or prejudice the right of that party with respect to recovery
179 of damages or other remedy as a result of such breach or default.

181 21. During the term of this Agreement, all parties agree not to discriminate on the basis of age,

184 participation or membership in the national guard, state defense force or any other reserve
185 component of the military forces of the United States, or political beliefs against any person,

197 23. This Agreement is intended to be an agreement solely between the parties hereto and for
198 their benefit only. No part of this Agreement shall be construed to add to, supplement, amend,
199 abridge or repeal existing duties, rights, benefits or privileges of any third party or parties, including
200 but not limited to employees of any party.

ADDENDUM OF AGREEMENT

THIS ADDENDUM, made and entered into effective as of the date by which both parties hereto have executed this document, by and between the Dane County Sheriff (hereinafter referred to as "Sheriff"), the County of Dane (hereafter, "County"), and the Village of Cambridge and Village of Deerfield, (hereafter, Municipalities").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS Sheriff, County, and Municipalities, by a separate document (hereinafter, the "Master Agreement"), County Agreement Number 4752, have previously entered into a contractual relationship pursuant to which the Sheriff provides law enforcement services within the Municipality, and

WHEREAS Municipalities wish to amend the Master Agreement to have the County provide a second police vehicle including equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above premises and the mutual covenants of the parties hereinafter set forth, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by each party for itself, the parties do agree as follows:

1. The Master Agreement shall remain in full force and effect unchanged in any manner by this addendum except as changes are expressly set forth herein. This addendum shall control only to the extent of any conflict between the terms of the Master Agreement and this addendum.
2. The existing terms of Paragraph 8 of the Master Agreement are deleted and replaced by the following terms: 8. The County shall provide two (2) police vehicles to be used by the deputies providing services pursuant to this Agreement. Both vehicles and all equipment contained therein shall remain the property of County. Municipalities shall reimburse Sheriff's Office the cost of the vehicle. The additional annual fee for the use of the vehicles is shown in Schedule A.
The Village of Deerfield will maintain and supply 3 traffic cones, 1 headlight flasher, 1 oxygen tank, 1 portable radio, 1 measuring wheel for Police Vehicle #115.
3. The existing terms of paragraph 9 of the Master Agreement are deleted and replaced by the following terms. 9. The Village of Cambridge will supply one (1) police vehicle which shall be available for use primarily by the deputy performing school resource officer services. This vehicle, including equipment and portable radio will be comparable and compatible to Sheriff's vehicles and shall be kept in good working order.
4. The total annual fee for services in Schedule A is increased \$6,848.69 to compensate the Sheriff for providing the second (2nd) police equipped vehicle.
