- 3. Application: Andrew & Dana Ferrell, 215 S Krueger Street, Suring requests permission to rezone parcel 18103130311050 (704 E Church Street) to residential from commercial to combine the two parcels into one with a certified survey. No questions or comments from the public. Landowner needs to provide Village with details of where utilities were capped when building was taken down on 704 E Church Street.**
- 4. Application: Suring Public School District, 411 E Algoma Street, Suring, requests conditional use for permission to build a 50' x 90' Student Market and Agricultural Center on the property located at 422 E Main Street. Public in attendance supported the project. School district informed public that the market would be open weekends and through the summer. There was discussion about advertising the building on Hwy 29 to bring patrons through the Village. The school district's goal is to have 3,000 customers from out of town visit the center during the first year. Students Pre-K through high school would utilize the building. Village Board Trustees inquired on timeline of project, informed school on animal ordinances, and informed school on process and procedures.**
