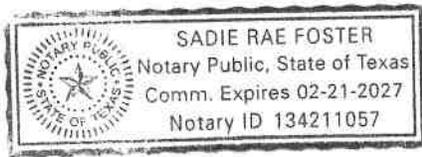
1. Items marked with an * are consent items considered to be non-controversial and will be voted on in one motion unless a council member asks for separate discussion.
