CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – JULY 24, 2024 MEETING

Motion (Martin/McKeon) to approve the July 24, 2024 minutes. Motion carried, all voting aye (4-0).

WATER AND SEWER UPDATE ON LEAD SERVICE LINE INVENTORY, METER REPLACEMENTS, LIFT STATIONS, AND OTHER IMPROVEMENTS

Nate Fosbinder provided an update on the Lead Service Line inventory, which is required to be submitted by October 16th to the DNR. The inventory will be posted on the City's website and residents can call or visit City Hall and request information. The City is required to notify residents if the service line is lead, galvanized, or unknown. Currently, there are 230 unknowns, 65 known lead, 35 known galvanized, 54 known plastic, 693 known copper, and 16 known other materials.

The City currently has 1,368 meters installed, of which 300 are manual reads, 853 are drive-by reads, and 215 are cellular reads. So far in 2024, the City has replaced 195 meters. Fosbinder would like to purchase 100 additional meters this year, with an additional 300 meters to be purchased in 2025.

The lift stations were recently cleaned and no issues were found. There will be a contractor doing preventative maintenance on 5 out of the 7 lift stations. The other two will not have maintenance as one is being replaced and the other is having all new controls and pumps installed. Preventative maintenance is something that should be done annually.

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DISCUSSION AND CONSIDERATION OF SEWER TELEVISIONING AND CLEANING CONTRACTS

The Finance Committee recommended Council approval proceeding with a 2-year contract with Flo-rite.

The City has approximately 20 miles of sanitary sewer. The requirement for televising and cleaning is a 10 year rotation, or cleaning 1/10th per year.

Motion (Martin/Christensen) to recommend Council approval of 2-year sewer televising and cleaning contract with Flowrite. Motion carried, all voting aye (4-0).

DISCUSSION AND CONSIDERATION OF ADDITIONAL METER REPLACEMENTS

Over the past few years, the City budgeted to replace around 130 meters. This year, 200 meter replacements were authorized.

The City currently has 1,368 meters installed, of which 300 are manual reads, 853 are drive-by reads, and 215 are cellular reads. So far in 2024, the City has replaced 195 meters. Fosbinder would like to purchase 100 additional meters this year, with an additional 300 meters to be purchased in 2025 to try to get all meters on an automated read by the end of 2025.

The PSC requirement is to replace meters on a 20-year rotation, if not in a testing schedule. There are currently over 40 meters older than 1990 (34 years), 217 older than 1994 (30 years), and 381 older than 2004 (20 years).

Motion (Christensen/McKeon) to recommend Council approval of an additional 100 meter replacements. Motion carried, all voting aye (4-0).

DISCUSSION AND CONSIDERATION OF STREETS DEPARTMENT PICK-UP TRUCK REPLACEMENT

The Finance Committee recommended staff get more quotes for a Street Department pick-up truck replacement and authorized the Streets, Water & Sewer Committee to recommend final approval to Council. The City will gather actual quotes for a minimum of two pick-up trucks.

Motion (Weier/Christensen) to recommend Council approval of City staff getting bids for a streets department pick-up truck replacement. Motion carried, all voting aye (4-0).

DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE CONSIDERATION OF CEMETERY PLOWING POLICIES

A St. Mary's/St. Paul's member reached out to the City asking if the City would still plow the cemeteries. There is an indemnification agreement in place, however Honer had not been able to find the signed agreements. Honer explained that the cemetery is not City property, and we don't plow for other organizations. Years ago, the Street Department would only plow the cemetery if there was a funeral but that became problematic if there was accumulation of snow.

Alder Weier's concern is City resources being used for private entities. He would've been more likely to agree to this if it was at the City's billable rate, rather than free. Alder Martin believes this is a policy the City needs to keep. He believes it is a service to the community. Alder Christensen believes this is

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something that can be reviewed from year to year. He would like to see a double indemnification so that it covers both parties before moving forward.

The Committee recommends Administrator Honer put together a contract with updated indemnification agreements to bring back to the next meeting.

No action taken.

EVALUATION OF BRUSH PICK-UP POLICY

Street Foreman Paul Mohlmann says the brush pick-up is improving. The Street Department puts door hangers out the week before picking up the brush. It has helped to free up time to get other projects completed within the Street Department.

The Committee would like to keep the new policy in place.

DISCUSSION OF OTHER STREETS, WATER, OR SEWER ITEMS

Alder McKeon asked when Commerce Street is plowed toward Old Darlington Rd, why the parking spaces in front of the Brewery and Popolo doesn't get plowed. It does get plowed per the Street Department, and they will pay closer attention to it this winter season.

ADJOURN.

Motion (Christensen/McKeon) to adjourn at 6:38 pm. Motion carried, all voting aye (4-0).

The Owner hereby releases and forever discharges the City from all manner of actions, causes of actions, suits, claims, and demands whatsoever, which against the City and its agents the Owner ever had, now has, or which the Owner hereafter can, shall, or may have for, by reason of any matter of thing done or neglected to be done by the City, in connection with snow plowing operations performed or to be performed by the City pursuant to this Agreement.

2. The Owner hereby agrees that he/she will at all times indemnify and save harmless the City, its servants, agents and employees from and against any and all claims for less or damages suffered by any person by reason or any matter or thing done or neglected to be done by the City in connection with snow plowing operations performed or to be performed by the City pursuant to this agreement.

3. The Owner agrees that in the event of damage to the City's equipment or personnel as a result of snow plowing operations, the Owner shall be liable to City for any damage to the snow plowing equipment and/or personnel which was caused by an act of negligence of Owner, its agents or employees or by a condition of the property under the Owner's control. A "condition of the property" includes defects in streets or obstructions in roads including, but not limited to, potholes, wires, depressions, obstacles and similar dangers. Owner shall not be liable for loss of or damage to equipment and supplies of the City, its agents or employees if such loss or damage was caused by the negligence of the City and/or Director's employees.

4. This agreement shall be a continuing agreement and shall not terminate until written notice of termination is given by either party to the other, but the agreements of the Owner expressed in paragraphs one and two hereof shall survive any termination of the agreement.

5. In the event any portion of the property is inaccessible due to parked vehicles, refuse containers, or any other cause or obstacle beyond the control of City such that City is unable to perform the work to that portion of the property, the City shall not perform snowplowing operations on such inaccessible area.

6. This agreement shall inure to the benefit and be binding upon the parties hereto and the respective executors, administrators, successors, and assigns.

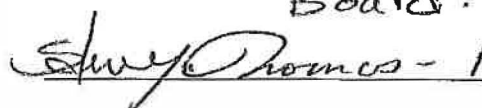

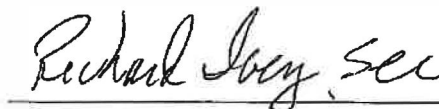
