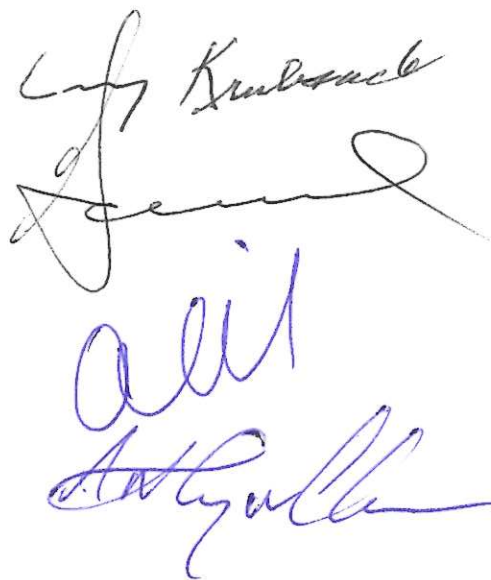

Meeting Minutes:

MONTHLY REPORT

July 2024

Streets

- The Streets crew has been keeping up with city properties mostly on a mowing schedule and fighting the rain each week. Overall as we closed the books in June, all parks and building grounds look great going into the holiday weekend.
- We have started the second round of street sweeping on city streets and plan on hitting the gutter edges to remove as much of the weeds growing as possible.

Public Works Fleet

- In April we had the woodchipper re-conditioned and have had some follow up problems the past month. We sent the chipper back to Vermeer near La Crosse to update the repairs. We will receive our chipper back on July 9 and Vermeer will work with our crew to ensure all is in working

order.

Water Utility

- On July 8 we plan on starting hydrant flushing throughout the city. This will take two weeks to complete.
- Approximately 80 hydrants were painted, and this work has been completed.

Sewer Utility

- On July 10 and 11 Crane Engineering will be at the wastewater plant to install one raw water pump and 2 check valves along with support structures for the valving. This work was approved last year.

Director Updates

- On Friday July 12, I will be attending a preconstruction meeting at the WisDOT offices in Wisconsin Rapids for the asphalt paving project for Prospect Avenue. I will provide an update after this meeting.

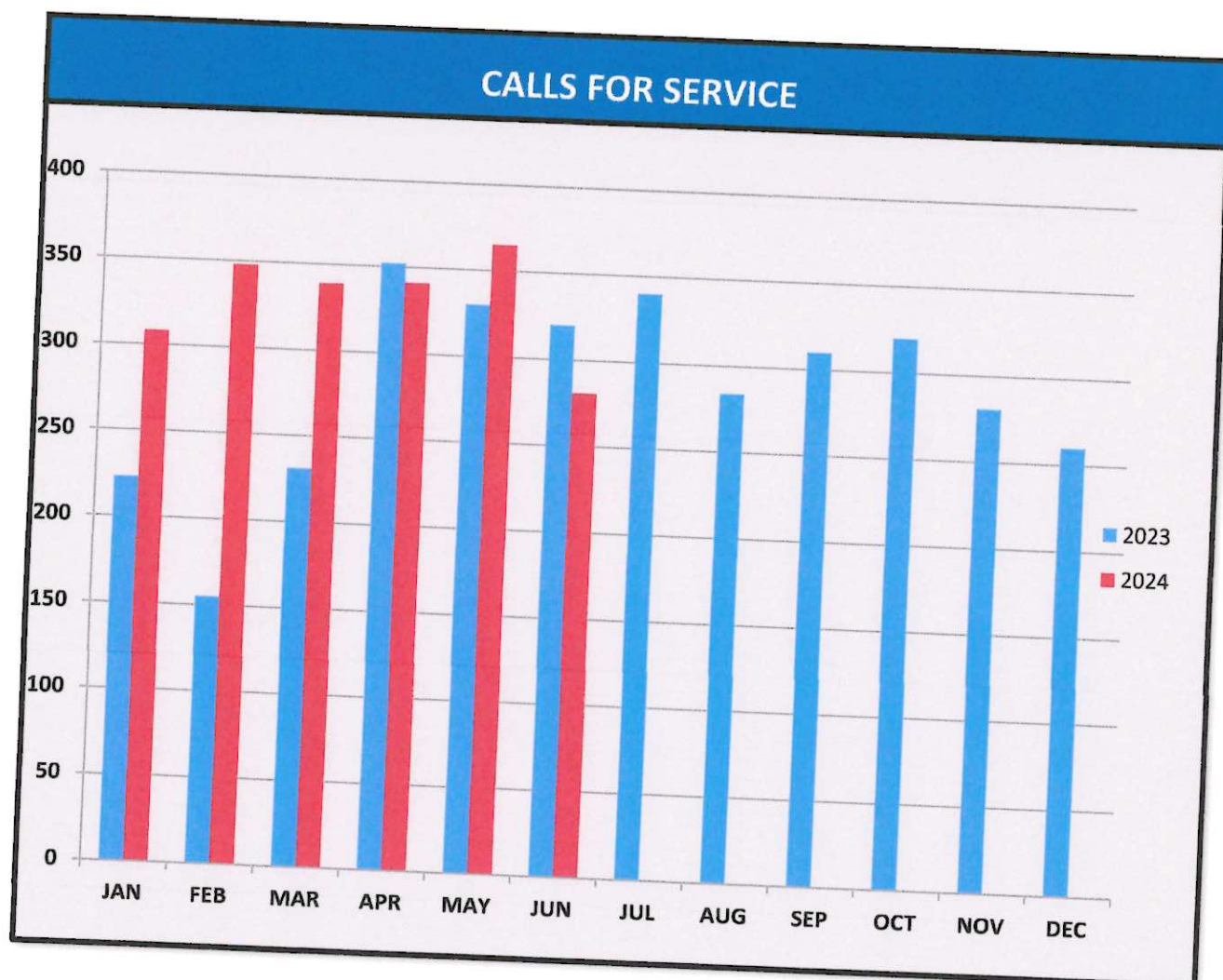
