

**MINUTES FROM THE  
CITY OF WAUTOMA  
MEETING OF THE REGULAR COMMON COUNCIL  
MONDAY, JULY 8<sup>th</sup>, 2024  
6:00 p.m.**

Mayor Nixon called the Regular Common Council meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, July 8<sup>th</sup>, 2024.

Present: Mayor Nixon, Alderpersons Pat King, Eric Tratar, Steve Ryerson, Aaron Grimm, Bob Cayer and Ryan Petersen

Prayer and Pledge took place.

Aldersperson Ryerson motioned to approve minutes from the Special Common Council meeting held on June 17<sup>th</sup>, 2024, Finance and Personnel Committee held on June 17<sup>th</sup>, 2024, and Public Safety meeting held on June 17<sup>th</sup>, 2024. The motion was seconded by Aldersperson Tratar and carried 6-0.

Administrator Bohler presented the review of bank account information.

Aldersperson Ryerson motioned to approve the Council agenda with the change to move item 15a up for immediate action. The motion was seconded by Aldersperson Grimm and carried 6-0.

Members from the Stevens Point YMCA and Waushara County YMCA organization committee on potential YMCA project spoke to the Common Council. After discussion, Aldersperson Grimm motioned to approve a \$500,000 development agreement investment that would be enacted in the 2025 Proposed Operating Budget. The motion was seconded by Aldersperson Tratar and carried 6-0 via roll call vote.

Aldersperson motioned to approve Ordinance #2024-02 regarding parking bans and Chief of Police Authorization on Events, per Public Safety Committee recommendations. The motion was seconded by Aldersperson Grimm and carried 6-0.

Administrator Bohler presented his report to Council.

Mayor Nixon presented his report to Council.

Police Chief Mott gave his report to Council.

Aldersperson Grimm motioned to approve the monthly vouchers, which was seconded by Aldersperson Cayer and carried 6-0.

Alderson Grimm motioned to approve Finance and Personnel recommendation to comply with the Federal Labor Standards Board decision regarding wages of Administrative Assistant. The motion was seconded by Alderson Cayer and carried 6-0.

No action was taken regarding speed limits on Youngman Street.

Alderson Grimm motioned to adjourn, which was seconded by Alderson Ryerson and carried 6-0. The meeting was adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
