

**MINUTES FROM THE
CITY OF WAUTOMA
MEETING OF THE REGULAR COMMON COUNCIL
MONDAY, JULY 10th, 2023
7:30 p.m.**

Mayor Nixon called the regular meeting of the City of Wautoma Common Council to order at 7:30 p.m. on Monday, July 10th, 2023.

Prayer and Pledge took place.

Alderperson King moved to approve the minutes from the Special Common Council meeting held on June 19th, 2023, Finance and Personnel meeting held on June 19th, 2023, and Planning Commission meeting held on June 24th, 2023. The motion was seconded by Alderperson Grimm and carried 5-0.

Mr. Bohler presented both the General Fund Budget Comparison and bank account report.

Alderperson Ryerson motioned to approve the agenda which was seconded by Alderperson Petersen and carried 5-0.

Chief Mott swore in Officers Ehrke and Lewandoski and welcomed them to the Wautoma Police Department

Alderperson Grimm motioned to approve Resolution #2023-08 Awarding the Sale of \$3,205,000 (adjusted from listed price on agenda) General Obligation Corporate Purpose Bonds, Series 2023A. The motion was seconded by Alderperson Tratar and carried 5-0.

Alderperson Ryerson moved to approve the payment of monthly vouchers. The motion was seconded by Alderperson Petersen and carried 5-0.

Alderperson Ryerson motioned to approve a \$1,000 donation to Augustfest, which was seconded by Alderperson Grimm and carried 5-0

Alderson King motioned to approve \$500 towards the completion of the County Cupboard mural project, which was seconded by Alderson Petersen and carried 5-0.

Alderson King motioned to approve development agreements with Rick Stafford for Lots 53, 54, and 55 in Lake Ridge Subdivision which was seconded by Alderson Ryerson and carried 5-0.

Alderson Petersen motioned to adjourn, which was seconded by Alderson Ryerson and carried 5-0. The meeting was adjourned at 8:55 p.m.
