

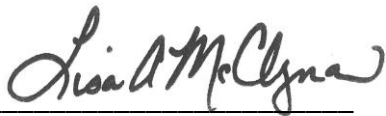
LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE MEETING

2. Motion by Ald. Ryan seconded by Ald. Anderson to approve the August 11, 2025 meeting minutes. Motion carried unanimously.
