2. Motion by Mayor Wojnicz seconded by Ald. Ryan to approve minutes from October 13, 2025 meeting. Motion carried.
3. Motion by Mayor Wojnicz seconded by Ald. Ryan to approve the DellShire Dr. dedication. Motion carried.
4. Motion by Ald. Ryan seconded by Mayor Wojnicz to approve MSA Task Order #00085123 – Parkway final design. Motion carried.
5. Motion by Mayor Wojnicz seconded by Ald. Ryan to approve DOT Compensable Documents. Motion carried.
6. Motion by Mayor Wojnicz seconded by Ald. Ryan to approve Tollaksen to make decisions on the parkway project as needed including the Parkway Project State/Municipal Maintenance Agreement based on Tollaksen’s approval. Parkway Project expected to start in Fall of 2026. Motion carried.
7. Motion by Mayor Wojnicz seconded by Ald. Ryan to approve No Parking signage on the 500 blk of Race Street during school hours. Motion carried.
8. Discussion only on leaf removal in City limits within the downtown area where there is curb and gutter. Those with no curb and gutter are able to bring leaves to the brush and leaf drop off at the Department of Public Works City shop.
9. Motion by Mayor Wojnicz seconded by Ald. Ryan to approve the Amtrak platform project. Motion carried.
10. Motion by Mayor Wojnicz seconded by Ald. Ryan to approve the changing of St. Cecilia parking stalls on corner of Minnesota & Oak to parallel parking stalls. Motion carried.
11. Discussion on the DOT Hwy 23 reconstruction project scheduled for 2028, Mayor Wojnicz reaching out to Waterman inquiring of any plans of development. Additional discussion of a multi-use patch along Hwy 23 in front of Oak Lawn Subdivision along with pedestrian facilities south on Hwy 16 to the Deerwood Glenn Subdivision. Discussion of erosion issues in front of the cemetery and the old public works shop.
12. Discussion on DOT interstate project to pursue a different interchange alternative, to have on and off ramps for both Hwy 13 and additionally County Rd H, revisiting the city’s comprehensive plan and planning documents for future developments on the west side of I-90/94 Exit 87. There was additional discussion on potential annexation further down trout road and pursuing pedestrian facilities on the Trout Rd interstate overpass.
