

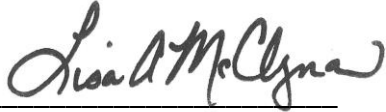
LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE MEETING
CITY OF WISCONSIN DELLS
February 9, 2026

Ald. Mike Freel called the meeting to order at 5:15PM. Notice of the meeting was provided to the *Dells Events*, WNNO Radio, and posted in accordance with State Statutes.

1. Present: Ald. Mike Freel, Mayor Ed Wojnicz, Ald. Troy Ryan, Ald. Ben Anderson

2. Motion by Ald. Ryan seconded by Ald. Anderson to approve the January 12, 2026 meeting minutes. Motion carried unanimously.
3. Motion by Ald. Ryan seconded by Mayor Wojnicz to recommend to Common Council for approval, an application for a Special Event Permit submitted by Wisconsin Dells Festivals, LLC for the Spring Wine Walk – 2026, for the licensing date of April 11, 2026. Motion carried unanimously.
4. Motion by Mayor Wojnicz seconded by Ald. Anderson to recommend to Common Council for approval, an application for a Special Event Permit submitted by Wisconsin Dells Festivals, LLC for Wisconsin Dells Automotion Classic Car Show – 2026 for the licensing period of May 15, 2026 through May 17, 2026. Motion carried unanimously.
5. Motion by Ald. Ryan seconded by Ald. Anderson to recommend to Common Council for approval, an original Class "B" Beer and "Class C" Liquor (wine only) License submitted by Concept Attractions, DBA The Guildhall, located at 400 Broadway for the licensing period of February 17, 2026 through June 30, 2026. Motion carried unanimously.
6. Motion by Ald. Anderson seconded by Ald. Ryan to recommend to Common Council for approval, a Proposed Ordinance to amend Code Sec 16.35(9) and 16.35(13) – Overnight Lodging. Motion carried unanimously.
7. Motion by Mayor Wojnicz seconded by Ald. Anderson to recommend to Common Council for approval, a Proposed Ordinance to amend Code Sec 16.10(3) and 16.10(4) – Busking. Motion carried unanimously.
8. Motion by Mayor Wojnicz seconded by Ald. Anderson to change the proposed ordinance amendment for 18.10(9) and to instead create Code Sec 1.08(6), and to update Code Sec 1.08(1), (2). These changes are recommended to Common Council for approval. Motion carried unanimously.
9. Motion by Ald. Ryan seconded by Ald. Anderson to recommend to Common Council for approval, a Proposed Ordinance to update Code Sec 4.16 – Retention of Nominal

Amounts. Motion carried unanimously.

10. Items for referral – Ald Freel suggested a meeting in April with Dan Marsich to discuss his 3 year plan.
11. Motion by Mayor Wojnicz seconded by Ald. Anderson to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously and the meeting adjourned at 5:24 pm.
