February 9, 2026

Mayor Wojnicz called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM. Notice of the meeting was provided to the Dells Events, WNNO Radio, and posted in accordance with State Statutes.

1. Present: Mayor Ed Wojnicz, Ald. Brian Holzem, and Ald. Troy Ryan

 Absent: Ald. Terry Marshall

 Others: Public Works Director Chris Tollaksen, City Administrator Karen Terry, Public Works Administrative Assistant Devan Mulroney, Clerk/Treasurer Lisa McClyman, Chief Nick Brinker, Ald. Freel, City Attorney Joseph Hassler, and Holly Swaney.
2. Motion by Ald. Ryan seconded by Ald. Holzem to approve minutes from January 12, 2026 meeting. Motion carried.
3. Motion by Mayor Wojnicz seconded by Ald. Holzem approve the Electric Utility Rates provided by the PSC. Motion carried.
4. Motion by Ald. Holzem seconded by Ald. Ryan to approve the DOT Recommended Functional Classification changes. Motion carried.
5. There was discussion on the temporary turn lane for Dellshire Dr. which will be about 60ft -100 ft long where 2-3 cars can wait to turn without impeding traffic on the parkway. The Wisconsin DOT will reimburse the city for the full cost of temporary turn lane expense.
6. There was discussion on the temporary signage during the Parkway Construction with DOT signage labeled as “Alternate Business Access”. In the DOT right away by Lake Street and by Pilgrim Road in the Village of Lake Delton the City would like to place a 4x8 sign. There was additional discussion of signage at the locations of Clare Ave & Lake Street (City of Wisconsin Dells to discuss with the Village of Lake Delton), at Clare Ave & Trout Road, and another sign at State HWY 13 & Trout Road. Discussion on all signs to be unified. There was discussion on the signs potentially being larger than 4x8 if possible.
7. Motion by Ald. Holzem seconded by Ald. Ryan to approve MSA Task Order 85146 – Road Maintenance. Motion carried.
8. There was discussion on what roads are planning to be repaired by milling and re-paving including Indiana Ave (River Rd – Oak St), Illinois Ave (Bowman Rd- Vine St). Also repaired by patch and chip seal Illinois Ave (Cedar – Church [2blks]). Additional roads were discussed as candidates for patching and chip sealing road repair including Cedar St (North & South of Broadway), Church St (between Michigan Ave & Illinois Ave), parts of Oak Lawn.
9. Next Public Works Meeting is scheduled for Monday, March 9, 2026.
10. Motion by Ald. Ryan seconded by Ald. Holzem to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:13 P.M.
