2. **Motion** by Ald. Ryan, seconded by Mayor Wojnicz, to approve the minutes from the June 8, 2026, meetings. **Motion carried.**
3. **Motion** by Ald. Holzem, seconded by Mayor Wojnicz, to approve the temporary closing of the sidewalk and to allow construction dumpsters to utilize 3 to 5 parking stalls with parking fees being waived until May 1, 2027. This approval accommodates the upcoming bank renovation at 701 Superior Street (former VCB building), which is scheduled to begin after Labor Day. **Motion carried.**
4. **Motion** by Ald. Holzem, seconded by Ald. Ryan, to approve MSA Task Order 85146 Amendment 1 for road improvement construction on Indiana Ave. and Illinois Ave. **Motion carried.**
5. **Motion** by Ald. Holzem, seconded by Ald. Ryan, to accept and place on file the progress report for the Wisconsin Dells 2026 Roadway Improvements, acknowledging the work scheduled to be completed soon on the following city streets:
 - **Indiana Ave (River Rd to Oak St) & Illinois Ave (Bowman Rd to Vine St):** Milling and paving scheduled for mid-to-late July.
 - **Illinois Ave (Cedar St to Capitol St):** Surface chip sealing to be completed when a crew becomes available.
 - **Michigan Ave (Bowman Rd to Vine St) & Plum St (Michigan Ave to Illinois Ave):** Full reconstruction of the utilities and roadway scheduled to begin in August, with an estimated duration of a few months.
