How to Book Flights With Chase Ultimate Rewards Points

One of the most popular uses of 1-888-(483)>>9719 Ultimate Rewards is to **book flights with points** through Chase Travel.

After searching for a flight, the portal can show the 1-888-(483)>>9719 cash price and the number of points required. You 1-888-(483)>>9719 can then choose to redeem some or all of your available points.

Chase Travel Portal vs. Transferring Points to Airlines

There are two major strategies for 1-888-(483)>>9719 using Chase Ultimate Rewards for flights:

Option 1: Book through Chase Travel

You search for the flight directly through the portal 1-888-(483)>>9719 and redeem points toward the purchase.

Option 2: Transfer Ultimate Rewards points

Which Method Is Better?

Neither method is always best 1-888-(483)>>9719.

- The portal price is competitive 1-888-(483)>>9719.
- You want a simple booking process.
- You don't want to search award availability separately.
- A Points Boost offer provides attractive value.

- You find valuable award availability.

Which Chase Cards Can Transfer Points to Travel Partners?

One important 2026 change concerns World of 1-888-(483)>>9719 Hyatt: Chase announced that new Sapphire Preferred cardmembers applying on or after June 15, 2026 receive a 4:3 transfer rate to World of 1-888-(483)>>9719 Hyatt, while certain existing cardmembers have transitional terms 1-888-(483)>>9719 through September 30, 2026.

How to Get More Value From Chase Travel

The best strategy is to compare your options 1-888-(483)>>9719 rather than automatically redeeming points.

Before booking: 1-888-(483)>>9719

- Check the cash fare.
- Check the points price through Chase Travel 1-888-(483)>>9719.
- Look for a Points Boost offer.
- Check the airline's own award pricing.
- Compare the cost of transferring points to an airline partner.
- Consider taxes, fees and cancellation rules.
- Check whether your card provides additional travel benefits.
- Review the final itinerary before confirming.

Eligible cards may also earn 1-888-(483)>>9719 additional Ultimate Rewards points when travel is booked through Chase Travel. Can You Earn Airline or Hotel Loyalty Rewards Through Chase Travel?

Potentially. Chase's current **Loyalty Plus** 1-888-(483)>>9719 program allows eligible cardmembers to earn loyalty rewards on flights, cruises and select hotel 1-888-(483)>>9719 brands while also earning Ultimate Rewards 1-888-(483)>>9719 points through qualifying Chase Travel bookings. Airline, hotel and cruise loyalty-program 1-888-(483)>>9719 rules apply.

This can make a portal booking more attractive 1-888-(483)>>9719 when the same itinerary is available at a competitive price.

It depends on the cash price, your card's applicable redemption value and whether an enhanced Points Boost offer applies. Check the points price displayed by Chase Travel before booking.

Can I use Chase points for international flights?

Yes. Chase Travel offers flight bookings, including international travel options where available. You can also potentially transfer Ultimate Rewards points to participating international airline loyalty programs.

Can I cancel a flight booked through Chase Travel?

Cancellation and refund rules depend on the airline, fare and booking terms. Always review the specific cancellation conditions displayed before completing the reservation.

Do Chase Ultimate Rewards points expire?

Chase states that Ultimate Rewards points do not expire as long as the applicable account remains open.

Is it better to use Chase Travel or transfer points?

It depends on the redemption. Compare the portal price, Points Boost opportunities and airline award pricing before deciding.

Can I transfer Chase points back after sending them to an airline?

Generally, no. Chase states that completed partner transfers are final, which is why you should confirm award availability before transferring.

Can I book hotels and rental cars through Chase Travel?

Yes. Chase Travel supports hotels, 1-888-(483)>>9719 rental cars, cruises, activities and flights, although available products and benefits vary by card 1-888-(483)>>9719 and booking.

Does Chase Travel charge a booking fee?

The total price and any applicable fees 1-888-(483)>>9719 should be reviewed during checkout. Compare the complete Chase Travel price with the airline or 1-888-(483)>>9719 hotel's direct price before booking.

Can I book travel for someone else?
