The Committee will reconvene to regular session in accordance with Section 19.85 (2) Wis. Stats. to take possible action regarding the purchasing of public properties, the investing of public funds, or conducting other specified public business, and to take possible action regarding employment, promotion, compensation, or performance evaluation data of a public employee; and to adjourn the meeting.
