The public employee has the right to demand that the evidentiary hearing be held in open session.

The Committee will reconvene to *regular session* in accordance with Wis. Stat. sec. 19.85(2), Wis. Stats., to take possible action regarding dismissal, demotion, licensing or discipline of any public employee or person licensed by a board or commission or the investigation of charges against such person, and to adjourn the hearing.

8. Adjourn the hearing.
