CALL TO ORDER

Chairperson Deb Kralovetz called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

REVIEW PREVIOUS MEMORIAL PARK SOFTBALL/BASEBALL RENOVATION PLANS

Kralovetz stated she was not on the committee when the previous plans were discussed, so she asked if there was anyone who could start a discussion. Goral said he had been in on previous meetings and shared the following:

- Strom water issues, but since then there has been a there has been a temporary fix that is working fine
- New dugouts
- Building at the lower diamond with water and sewer for bathrooms, and concessions
- Back up the backstop on the upper diamond to the scorer's booth
- New two-story press box

Goral stated he thinks the lower diamond is ok with what they have now, however the outfield has to be redone, as it is very bumpy and hilly. Goral feels the outfield should be stripped and re soded or re seeded. Goral received and shared with the Committee a quote for the upper diamond renovation, and he will ask the same company if they could do the lower diamond outfield also (would be done in August or September)

Kralovetz asked if they had to make a timeline for the improvements, what would that be.

O'Brien stated he would like to see larger more modern dugouts, new fencing from first base to third base with the backstop moved back to the scorer's booth, and a press box.

Goral shared the Tech Ed class at the high school just build a press box for the soccer field, and he stated he can ask if they could do it for the upper diamond if materials and concrete are provided.

Kralovetz asked about funds, and O'Brien stated if the Baseball Club does something they would pay for one complete project of the three (3) listed.

Kralovetz also shared some pictures from Citizen's Park in Manitowoc. Everyone agreed they liked the look of the fence and backstop at Citizen's. Kralovetz asked if someone knew a company that did fencing and backstops. Goral stated he would contact UWGB as they just redid their fencing and backstop.

Leiterman/Steffek moved to recommend to the Village Board to approve the upper and lower diamond renovations to the fields contingent on the quotes that Goral receives. Motion carried.
