NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the Plan Commission of the Village of Denmark, Brown County Wisconsin, on Tuesday, April 16, at 4:30 p.m. at the Denmark Village Hall, 118 East Main Street, Denmark at which time the Plan Commission will hear public comments on the proposed rewrite of the Village Subdivision of Land Ordinance, Chapter 265 of the Village of Denmark Municipal Code.

The Subdivision of Land Ordinance regulates and controls the division of land within the Village in order to promote the public health, safety, morals, prosperity, aesthetics, and the general welfare. Amendments proposed for consideration include:

- General updates to enhance legal defensibility
- Additional standards for proposed lots
- Clearer procedures for Certified Survey Maps
- Updated requirements for Concept Plats, Preliminary Plats, and Final Plats
- Establishment of procedures for Conservation Design Subdivisions
- Submittal procedures for Plats of Survey and Lot Line Adjustments
- Requirements for Park Dedications, Reservations, and Improvements
