**BOARD DISCUSSION/ACTION ON A REQUEST TO EXTEND SEWER TO A PROPERTY IN
THE VILLAGE**

***Trustee Michael Johnson recused himself from the meeting during discussion of
this item.***

Selner stated the last lot on Danish Way was purchased to build a residence, and there is no sewer or water to the lot. The owner of the lot is requesting that water and sewer be extended to accommodate that parcel, and asked if the Village would help with the cost.

DISCUSSION

- No roads/sewer and water will be put in until the subdivision to the south of that parcel is developed
- The cost with sanitary sewer, manhole, sanitary lateral, would need a grinder pump would be roughly around \$35-36,000
- That should be on the owner
- The Village could do the work and assess for it
- After looking at the map, the parcel appears to be included in the area of the homes on the east side of the north end of Danish Way. The road was not finished to the end and utilities/curb and gutter should have been run to that parcel when the road was put in.
- Owner does excavating and has access to equipment and would be willing to help with the project

Steffek/Goral moved to grant the request to extend water and sewer to VD-799-2 and split the cost with the property owner. Motion carried. Johnson abstained.

CLOSED SESSION

Goral/Bielinski moved to convene into closed session pursuant to: Wis. Statute 19.85(1)(c), considering employment, promotion, compensation, or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercised responsibility. Johnson– aye, Goral– aye, Steffek – aye, Bielinski–aye, Selner – aye. Motion carried.
