NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the Village Board of the Village of Denmark, Brown County Wisconsin, on Tuesday, February 20, 2026, at 4:30 p.m. at the Denmark Village Hall, 118 East Main Street, Denmark at which time the Village Board will hear public comments on proposed amendments to the Village Zoning Ordinance, Chapter 315 Of the Village of Denmark Municipal Code.

The Zoning Ordinance regulates the use of land and divides the Village into several different zoning districts, as represented on the Village of Denmark Zoning Map. Amendments proposed for consideration include:

Amending Section 325-56 (C), dimensional standards, of Chapter 315, Zoning pertaining to building height in the R-4 Multi-family District changing maximum height from 35' to 45'

Building and Structure Standards - R-4 District

Maximum height	35 feet ^b
