NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the Board of Trustees (hereafter, Board) of the Village of Denmark, Brown County Wisconsin, on September 14, 2026, from 4:30 p.m. to 4:45 p.m. at the Denmark Village Hall, 100 N. Wall Street, Denmark at which time the Board will hear public comments on a request by staff to amend Section 315-199.G(1) of the Village of Denmark Zoning Ordinance to read as follows:

‘All ground-mounted signs for which a permit is required shall be set in a landscaped base of appropriate size to provide shrubs and base plantings that will enhance and compliment the sign. A landscaped base shall entail a structure or planter box within which required landscaping shall be set and of sufficient size to accommodate said landscaping.’

All interested persons will be given an opportunity to be heard. Testimony may be provided in writing or in person.
