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# **Delaware Water Gap Borough Council Special Meeting Minutes June 15, 2026**

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## **Call to order**

The Special Meeting of the Borough Council of Delaware Water Gap to read Mountain Road Pedestrian Safety Project Phase 1 bids on Monday, June 15, 2026. ### **New Business**

- Engineer Hutchison read the Mountain Road Pedestrian Safety Project bids for Phase 1. There were four bids received on Pennbid.
  - 1) ISG, LLC: \$159,499.00
  - 2) Northeast Site Contractors: \$185,888.90
  - 3) Gaver Industries Barker & Barker: Inc \$186,471.50
  - 4) RHL Companies: \$337,457.27
- T & M issued a Project Reward Recommendation Letter on June 15.

Upon review of the bid tabulation and submitted documents it was determined that ISG, LLC has met the minimum acceptable criteria for bid submission, as required by the Advertisement for Bids and all bids were checked for completeness, mathematical errors, and for accuracy. T & M requested references and similar completed projects and the original bid bond needs to be submitted to the Borough Hall.

- I. Foster made a motion to award the bid for the Mountain Road Pedestrian Safety Project to ISC. LLC in the amount of \$159,499.00 contingent upon receiving the original bid bond and references. Seconded by R. Plamer. All in favor.
- Discussion about grant funds remaining after the project is completed. Engineer Hutchinson suggested the scope of the project could be amended to include traffic safety calming projects.
