For: **One-Way Traffic Request – Scott Street**

- **Proposal:** To receive public comment regarding a resident request to designate Scott Street between Shaw Avenue and Wilson Street, adjacent to Elmwood School, as a one-way street and to consider related traffic flow and parking changes.

Meeting Location: Village Hall; 323 W. Winter Avenue
