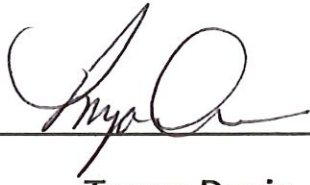

Adjourn:

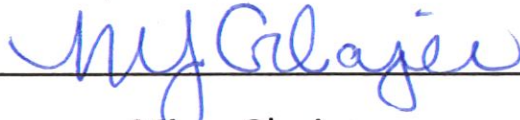
