Town Council Meeting

Opening of Meeting:

The meeting was held at Fortville Town Hall, 714 E. Broadway. Meeting was called to order by Council President Tonya Davis at 7:02 pm.

Approval of Agenda:

Ryan Rummell made the motion to approve the agenda with Becky Davis seconding. Motion carried, passed 4-0.

Approval of Minutes

Ryan Rummell made the motion to approve the November 20, 2023, Council Meeting Minutes with Becky Davis seconding. Motion carried, passed 4-0.

New Business:

- a. Steve Lindway, Andy Nahrwold, & Adelle DuSold of INDOT along with Wayne Jester & Grant Abbott of Milestone to provide an update on INDOT's U.S. 36 (Broadway) Project - Steve Lindway and Grant Abbott present update. Steve states audit conducted on ramps, and all are within the federal requirements; addressed email from Audrey regarding lane confusion - issue addressed; addressed email from Lacey as well. Grant presents update on construction and lane closures for project. Chief Bratton asks about the turn lane issue and Steve and Grant state they will address it.

Old Business:

- a. Council to consider the 2nd Reading of the 2024 Salary Ordinance 2023-11A – Becky Davis moves to approve on 2nd reading as presented with Tonya Davis seconding. Motion carried, passed 3-0 with Ryan Rummell abstaining.

Joe Renner voices appreciation for work done on Winterfest / states that water treatment plant parking lot was paved / provides update on water main break from a pipe installed in approximately 1913 - 1960s. Tonya asks about people having problems flushing toilets - Joe states that only during break but persistent problem could be from sediment in aerators. Becky asks about lead pipes in town - Joe states that no lead pipes in a traditional sense but now galvanized pipe is considered "lead" pipe so inventory being conducted.

Parks Manager:

Adam Zaklikowski announces that demolition prep has begun with house on Noel and demo should be done this week.

Clerk-Treasurer:

Police Chief:

Chief Bratton echoes Joe's comments on Winterfest and use of area for Kid Zone. Shop with a Cop is this weekend and provides update on event.

Question regarding clarity of water and aerators from Ms. Compliment - Joe explains that aerators and sediment in lines could be the issue and also the sediment and rust that is inherent from wells that town pulls its water from, but once the town can flush all of the

hydrants, the issue should clear up — states that # of houses being built is not the issue and capacity of new plant can handle new houses — additional discussion had on issue.

Vanessa - Asks about the locating or relocating of services and whether that is included in part of their November 2023 - November 2024 timeframe - Joe states it is a 30-month project, and they are on schedule - additional discussion had.

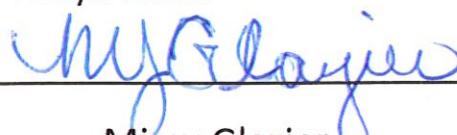
Ryan Rummell made the motion to approve and sign vouchers, with Becky Davis seconding. Motion carried, passed 4-0.
