7. Ashbeck motioned to approve the fence permit ordinance 13-1-142 (M) amendment to read as follows:
Fence Permit Required. No person shall erect a fence in the City without first obtaining a fence permit from the City and paying a fee established by the Greenwood Common Council. The applicant shall provide the Zoning Administrator with accurate design information for the proposed fence. Permits may only be issued for proposed fences complying with this Section.

8. Hinker motioned to approve the Police Union Contract as presented for 2026-2027. Ashbeck seconded the motion. All ayes. Motion carried.
9. Ashbeck motioned to approve the bills and vouchers as presented. Nelson seconded the motion. Roll call vote. All ayes. Motion carried.
