

Greenwood Council Meeting
Wednesday, February 18, 2026 at 6:00pm
201 S Main St- Council Chambers

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Hansen. Roll call- Nelson, Behrens, Hinker and Ashbeck all present. Also present Clerk/ Treasurer Kayla Schar, Public Works Director Eddie Herrick, Police Chief Andrew Kohnert, Utility Director Trent Johnson, Attorney Bonnie, and Representatives from Greenwood Milk Products.

Public Hearing:

Public Hearing was held at 6:00pm for a conditional use permit that would allow Greenwood Milk Products to build a 7,165 SF 1-story addition that would be inlayed between the existing building for dry storage and warehouse space. No citizens present for comments. Mayor Hansen called for comments three times. Public Hearing was closed at 6:09pm.

New Business:

1. Behrens motioned to approve a Conditional Use Permit that would allow Greenwood Milk Products to build a 7,165 SF 1-story addition that would be inlayed between the existing building for dry storage and warehouse space as recommended by Planning and Zoning Commission on the condition that all Greenwood Ordinances are followed. Nelson seconded the motion. Hinker and Ashbeck abstain. Motion carried.
2. Ashbeck motioned to approve the purchase of a Panasonic Toughbook FZ-55 for the new squad from Baycom for \$4,036. Hinker seconded the motion. All ayes. Motion carried.
3. Discussion regarding Police Department Policy and Procedures updates. Chief Kohnert would like to use CSI for assistance on the policy updates. Council is requesting more information regarding cost and proof of policy requirements before approval.
4. Nelson motioned to put bids out for a 3-year lawn mowing contract for 8 acres of property located on Willard Road, 2 acres of property located on Highway G and the Greenwood Cemetery. Bids will be accepted until March 13th at 4pm and will be awarded on the March 18th Council meeting at 6:00pm. Behrens seconded the motion. All ayes. Motion carried.
5. Hinker motioned to sell the Sewer Jetter when ready on the Wisconsin Public Surplus. Ashbeck seconded the motion. All ayes. Motion carried.
6. Hinker motioned to approve the agreement with Mike Ehlers for scrap metal pile removal for 6 months. Complete agreement on file with Clerk Schar. Nelson seconded the motion. All ayes. Motion carried.
7. Nelson motioned to approve the Summer Fest Committee members as presented. Ashbeck seconded the motion. All ayes. Motion carried.
8. Behrens motioned to approve opening up a Deputy Clerk/ Treasurer position as recommended by the Personnel Committee. Ashbeck seconded the motion. All ayes. Motion carried.
9. Ashbeck motioned to approve the bills and vouchers as presented. Hinker seconded the motion. Roll call vote. All ayes. Motion carried.
10. Behrens motioned to approve the minutes as written. Nelson seconded the motion. All ayes. Motion carried.
11. Nelson motioned to adjourn. Behrens seconded the motion. All ayes. Motion carried.
