

Greenwood Council Meeting
Wednesday, March 18, 2026 at 6:00pm
201 S Main St- Council Chambers

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Hansen. Roll call- Nelson, Behrens, Hinker and Ashbeck all present. Also present Clerk/ Treasurer Kayla Schar, Public Works Director Eddie Herrick, Police Chief Andrew Kohnert, and Attorney Bonnie Wachsmuth.

Old Business:

1. Discussion took place regarding the police department policy and procedure updates with CSI. Hinker motioned to table the discussion till the April 15th meeting to allow Chief Kohnert to gather more information on what policies would be needed instead of approving a completely new set of policies. Ashbeck seconded the motion. All ayes. Motion carried.

New Business:

1. Lawn mowing bids were opened for a 3-year contract from spring of 2026 till spring of 2029 for mowing of the Cemetery, Highway G wells and Willard Rd ponds. One bid received from Curley Creek Lawn Care. Cemetery mowing per time \$340, Highway G wells per time \$155, and Willard Rd ponds per time \$105. Behrens motioned to approve the 3-year contract. Hinker seconded the motion. All ayes. Motion carried.
2. Nelson motioned to approve the Town Web Design contract for online payments, reservations and licensing. Ashbeck seconded the motion. All ayes. Motion carried.
3. Hinker motioned to approve allowing Greenwood non-profit organizations and clubs to rent the ball field and pavilions at George Scherer Park without paying a rental fee. Non-profits must show proof of being a non-profit, complete all necessary forms to reserve the facility and must leave the facility in good condition. If damages occur during the use of the facility, the non-profit must agree to pay for any and all damages. Behrens seconded the motion. All ayes. Motion carried.
4. Nelson motioned to approve allowing Country Wireless, LLC to sublease the tower located at 44°44'27"N 90°32'05"W from Clark County, Wisconsin to install equipment to provide wireless internet access service ("WIAS") to commercial and residential customers. Ashbeck seconded the motion. All ayes. Motion carried.
5. Ashbeck motioned to approve the bills and vouchers as presented. Nelson seconded the motion. Roll call vote. All ayes. Motion carried.
6. Ashbeck motioned to approve the minutes as written. Hinker seconded the motion. All ayes. Motion carried.

Closed Session:

Closed Session pursuant to S.S. 19.85 (1)(g) Wis. Stats. for the purpose of conferring with legal counsel for the governmental body who is rendering oral or written advice concerning strategy to be adopted by the body with respect to litigation in which it is or is likely to become involved, specifically to discuss Attorney letter regarding surveys.

2. Behrens motioned to enter into closed session. Hinker seconded the motion. Roll call vote. All ayes. Motion carried.
3. Ashbeck motioned to adjourn closed session and reconvene into open session. Behrens seconded the motion. Roll call vote. All ayes. Motion carried.
