Monday, January 15, 2024

Motion by Hanke, seconded by Beyer to approve Resolution #2-2024, Adopting the Vernon County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan 2023-2028. Motion carried.

Motion by Lankey, seconded by Hotek to go into closed session at 7:11 P.M. Sec. 19.85(1)(e). Wis Stats., sanctions the use of closed sessions where governmental bodies are deliberating or negotiating the purchase of public properties, the investing of public funds, or conducting other specified public business, whenever competitive or bargaining reasons require a closed sessions.
