



COMMON COUNCIL MINUTES

Monday, February 17, 2025

The Common Council Meeting was called to order by Mayor Greg Kubarski on Monday, February 17, 2025 at 7:00 PM. All present stood and recited the Pledge of Alliance. Mayor Kubarski asked for affirmation of proper public notice to which City Clerk Sheila Schraufnagel confirmed the meeting did receive proper public notice.

Roll call was taken with Alderpersons Leanne Beyer, Thomas Hotek, Patricia Moen, Darrow Novy, Elizabeth Parish, and Randy Seeley present. Rick Hanke and Mark Lankey were absent.

Others in attendance were: City Administrator Joshua Finch, City Clerk Sheila Schraufnagel, Police Chief Patrick Clark, Brad and Rebecca Muller, and Hillsboro Sentry Editor, Nicolette Nauman.

Motion by Seeley, seconded by Beyer to approve the January 20, 2025 Common Council minutes. Motion carried.

Registered Public Comment:

There were no Registered Public Comments.

Motion by Hotek, seconded by Moen to approve the monthly bills for payment. Motion carried.

At 7:01 P.M. the Council held a hearing for re-consideration of the decision to deny the Combination Class B Alcohol License (beer & liquor) to Mom & Pop's Family Restaurant. Brad and Rebecca Muller were present to express their concerns and question the reason for the denial of the liquor license.

Motion by Beyer, seconded by Moen to convene in closed session at 7:34 P.M. under §19.85 (1)(a), Wis. Stats., for deliberating on the re-consideration hearing on the denial of the Combination Class B Alcohol License (beer & liquor) to Mom & Pop's Family Restaurant, LLC. Motion carried.

Motion by Beyer, seconded by Hotek to reconvene to open session at 7:58 P.M. to deliver decision on re-consideration hearing concerning Mom & Pop's Family Restaurant, LLC license application. Motion carried.

Beyer stated, "Based on the information tonight, I make a motion to deny the Alcohol Beverage License to Mom & Pop's Family Restaurant due to repeated issues of delinquent utilities, tax bills, and municipal loans dating back to 2014." Moen seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
