October 20, 2025

The Common Council Meeting was called to order by Mayor Greg Kubarski on Monday, October 20, 2025, at 7:00pm.

All present stood and recited the Pledge of Alliance.

Mayor Kubarski asked for affirmation of proper public notice to which City Administrator Isaacs confirmed the meeting did receive proper public notice.

Motion by Novy, seconded by Hanke to approve Special Use Park Permit: Field Veterans Memorial Park, May 16, 2026. Motion carried by voice vote.

Motion by Beyer, seconded by Hanke to approve Employee Handbook: Maternal, Paternal, and Adoption Leave Action. Motion carried by voice vote.

Motion by Hanke, seconded by Beyer to approve 2025's Trick or Treat Date and Time. Motion carried by voice vote.

Motion by Hanke, seconded by Hotek to enter closed. Motion carried by voice vote and entered closed session at 8:06pm. Section 19.85(1)(e), Wis. Stats. Sanctions the use of closed sessions for specific purposes such as deliberating or negotiating the purchasing of public properties, the investing of public funds, or conducting other specified public business, whenever competitive or bargaining reasons require a closed session.
