



CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
February 16, 2026

The Common Council Meeting was called to order by Mayor Greg Kubarski on Monday, February 16, 2026, at 7:01PM.

All present stood and recited the Pledge of Alliance.

Mayor Kubarski asked for affirmation of proper public notice to which City Administrator Isaacs confirmed the meeting did receive proper public notice.

Roll call was taken with Alderpersons Leanne Beyer, Pat Moen, Darrow Novy, Liz Parish, and Randy Seeley present in person. Alderpersons Tom Hotek and Mark Lankey were present via telephone. Rick Hanke was absent.

Others in attendance were: City Administrator Cory Isaacs, Administrative Associate Sara McDonald, Police Chief Pat Clark, Hillsboro Sentry Editor Nicolette Nauman, Marnie Hofmeister-Pooley of Let's Shine Coffee Shop, and Mike Burch.

Motion by Parish, seconded by Beyer to approve January 19, 2026, City Council Minutes as presented. Motion carried by voice vote.

There was no Registered Public Comment.

Committee Reports and Business

Motion by Lankey, seconded by Parish to approve the monthly bills for payment. Motion carried by voice vote.

Chief Clark gave the Police Chief's report stating 227 calls for service in the month of January. Chief Clark was attending the Police Chiefs Conference for the Committee Meeting. He was able to secure donated uniforms and vests for the department through possible new vendors at the conference.
