

SEWER TASK FORCE  
Meeting Notes  
June 13, 2022

The meeting of the Hillsdale Sewer Tsk Force was called to order at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, June 13, 2022 at Town Hall.

The Meeting Notes of the February 15, 2022 were approved as presented.

Mike reported that the system was operating well, with 9,100 gallons per day for the month of May. Nitrate levels were recorded in the normal range. Ongoing maintenance included replacement of a malfunctioning pump and pumping of a 3,000 gallon tank. Mike has received the annual DEC report and will forward it to members for their review.

The inventory list prepared by Mike has been digitized by Jill and presented to the group. The next step will be for Steve and Mike to identify and price the major items in order to establish the value of assets.

Kathi reported that billings are up to date, with the third quarter billings scheduled for July.

The sewer debt repayment issue is on hold pending a review of 2014-2020 records by CPA Bob Patterson. This review was commissioned by the Town of Hillsdale.

Steve reminded the group that it would be desirable for us to sign up for the no-fee PFAS cost recovery class action suit. Matt Cabral will review and advise. Steve also suggested that we continue to consider the WaterWorks proposal when it is economically feasible to do so.

Next meeting dates in October were discussed with details to be determined.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:05 p.m.
